

HLTAID004 PROVIDE AN EMERGENCY FIRST AID RESPONSE IN AN EDUCATION AND CARE SETTING

This course is for educators and support staff working within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies. The course is based on the new competencies that the Australian Children's Education and Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) has endorsed as satisfying all educator requirements for first aid, asthma and anaphylaxis qualifications.

You will need to complete a workbook prior to course commencement. These can be collected from your Community College.

Please note: It is required, during the assessment that demonstration of CPR must be done on the floor. Students will be required to complete two demonstrations and must be prepared to kneel for up to 10 minutes during the CPR component assessment time.
