

Thank you for your interest in the 2021 Directors Studio: Stage and Screen

Entry to the Directors Studio: Stage and Screen is by presentation at interview.

We are looking for candidates with commitment and a curiosity about the creative process.

Interview requirements:

Prepare a 10-minute presentation of a directing concept you'd like to create for live performance. Consider the content and style of your imagined project, what venue would suit it and what impact you intend to have on your intended audience.

OR

Prepare a 10-minute presentation of a directing concept you'd like to create for screen. Consider the content and style of your imagined project, whether it would be best suited to location or a studio setting, and what impact you think it will have on your intended audience.

Think creatively about images, words and ideas to communicate the work you would like to make and use this opportunity to introduce yourself and the things which inspire you.

You can bring your images on either a USB or hard copy format.

Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your interview and wait for your group to be called. Interviews are conducted in a group – everyone is in the room throughout the whole process. The interview lasts up to three hours and you are required to stay for the whole time.

Things to remember

- Rehearse your interview presentation before your interview so that you feel prepared.
- Be open and engaging with the other people in your group. We are looking for people who can work well together, as well as develop individually.
- You may bring bottled water into NIDA's rehearsal rooms; however, no other food or drink is permitted.

Once you have been interviewed, we will contact you within 2 weeks to let you know the outcome. If we are able to offer you a place in the course and you wish to accept it, you will need to arrange payment for the course prior to course commencement.
