

NIDA Open students:

As you may be aware, Sydney Light Rail construction is currently underway on Anzac Parade. We have received an update from Transport for NSW advising how the latest construction activity may affect your access to NIDA.

From 8pm on Friday 25 November, the following changes to traffic conditions will be implemented:

- Parking and bus lanes on both sides of Anzac Parade, from High Street to Barker Street, will be removed and a 24 hour clearway will be introduced.
- A 50km/h speed limit will be introduced in this section of Anzac Parade.
- There will be no right turn from Day Avenue onto Anzac Parade.
- Most bus stops located outside NIDA or UNSW will either be relocated around clearways or closed through the construction period. Public transport to NIDA is still available; please visit transportnsw.info for the latest transport updates and to plan your trip.

Access to buildings, driveways and pedestrian footpaths will be maintained, NIDA patrons will still be able to access the UNSW car park via the Day Avenue entrance. Please note that the regular parking restrictions and fees for parking in the UNSW car park will still apply through this period.

In addition to the above traffic restrictions there are several events occurring in the NIDA building through November and December that will impact parking availability. We advise all patrons attending an event or scheduled class to allow additional travel time.

We thank you for your understanding and continued patronage through this busy time. NIDA is operating as usual through the Sydney Light Rail construction and we will endeavour to update you on changed traffic conditions as information becomes available.
