- 1. Have you had any close contact with a covid-19, positive case?
- 2. Have you been tested for covid-19 and currently awaiting the results?
- 3. Have you been to victoria in the last 14 days?
- 4. Have you returned from overseas in the last 14 days?
- 5. Do you reside, or have you visited a hotspot suburb/location in any state or territory in the last 14 days?
- 6. Do you have any cold or flu-like symptoms?

SCREENING OUESTIONS

If you answer **yes** to **ANY** of the following questions, you may not attend Gallery307 Art School premise and we strongly encourage you to contact your Medical Practitioner.

STAY AT HOME IF YOU ARE SICK

If you or your child is sick, please do not attend a class at the art school. Contact our team and we will be happy to organise for you or your child to join us on line through zoom.

If you have flue like symptoms do not attend . Contact your doctor for advice.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) may be worn by our team, such as masks, gloves, and face shields. This is for your safety and ours.

Temperature checks and screening questions upon arrival – any one with a temperature above 37.5 degrees Celsius will be asked to leave and seek medical advice. In the case of an after school student parents will be expected to collect their student as soon as possible. The student will be moved away from the group and asked to wear a mask.

A sign in sheet, to screen for COVID-19 symptoms

Hand sanitizer available

Physical distancing / room occupancy limits

Surfaces cleaned regularly

Equipment baskets for each class to avoid cross contamination between groups

Class work taken home each session, if teacher requests artwork to be left for the following week it must be kept separate from any other group.

If your child attends on a day when there are two classes. They will be allocated a pick-up room to avoid congestion and allow for better physical distancing. Sometime physical distancing can be a problem at pick up so it may be advisable to wear a mask to keep safe.
