Delivery Mode: This qualification is delivered through a blend of formal face to face classes, self-paced learning and work placement. Learners will work through course material with a trainer and complete assessments during class and non-class allocated time.

Assessment: A variety of assessment methods are used including written Q&A, observations, case studies or projects. Trainer will visit the learner during their work placement a minimum of 3 times to conduct practical assessment and to provide assistance wherever required to learner and employer.
