### **Industry Requirements**

Candidates are required to provide evidence of the following for work placement:

- National Police Check
- Current First Aid Certificate

At least 2 units must be from those units listed under Groups A, B or C up to 2 units from the electives listed, any endorsed Training Package or accredited course – these units must be relevant to the work outcome

Any combination of electives that meets the rules above can be selected for the award of the Certificate III in Individual Support. Where appropriate, electives may be packaged to provide a qualification with a specialisation.

Packaging for each specialisation:

- All Group A electives must be selected for award of the Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing).
- All Group B electives must be selected for award of the Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability).
- At least four units from Group C electives must be selected for award of the Certificate III in Individual Support (Home and Community).

Where two specialisations are completed award of the qualification would read Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing, Home and Community). All electives chosen must contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome.
