

HOW to prepare your Photo for Resin



CAUTION:

Being able to use your photo, you need to make sure that your photo is completely sealed before pouring the resin, as the resin will otherwise stain.

Please note: Sydney Community College cannot guarantee you the success of your work.

To successfully seal your photo, you need:

- Wax paper or aluminum foil
- Mod Podge (Lincraft or online at <http://www.hobbycraftandscrap.com.au>)
- Brush

How to? – Step-by-Step Instructions:

Step 1

Cut the photo into the size you would like to have it.

Step 2

Place the photo against a piece of wax paper or aluminum foil.

Step 3

Use the brush to coat the photo with a thin layer of sealant (Mod Podge) thoroughly.

Note: With time your sealant will go clear.

Step 4

Wait ten minutes to dry.

Step 5

Repeat step 2 with the back of your photo.

Note: Make sure, that your photo is completely covered with the sealant. Any small part that is not sealed will result in discolour your image.

Step 6

Wait ten minutes to dry.

Step 7

Bring your photo into class to embed into your jewellery piece.
