

HOW ONE WOMAN REDISCOVERED HERSELF AND NOW INSPIRES OTHERS

When Casey first walked into SGSCC as a student during the uncertainty of COVID, the idea of returning to study as an adult was daunting. With decades spent in the workforce and time at home raising young twins, her confidence was at an alltime low. But what she found at SGSCC was more than just a classroom, it was a turning point.
