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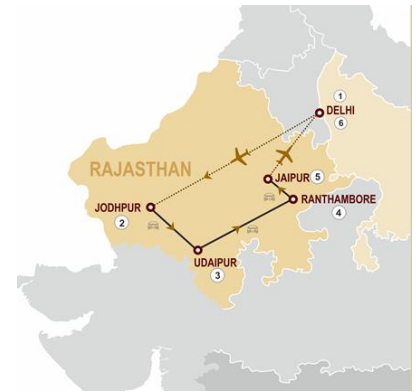

# Wildlife Photography and beyond In Royal Rajasthan

## ESCORTED TOUR 14 days / 13 nights in India

**Jodhpur – Udaipur – Ranthambore – Jaipur – Jhalana**



**Rajasthan**, known as the "Land of Kings" and India's largest desert state, is a captivating destination in northern India that mesmerise travellers from around the world. The state presents a harmonious blend of lively cities, hospitable locals, exquisite cuisine, majestic palaces, and grand forts. Rajasthan offers a perfect travel experience, seamlessly fusing timeless allure with contemporary charm. This enchanting state beckons you with a symphony of vibrant cultures, a canvas painted with tales of valour, and landscapes that will steal your heart. Rajasthan wears its regal history proudly, and its heritage sites are living testaments to the grandeur of its past. Beyond its royal heritage, Rajasthan boasts a diverse and captivating natural landscape. The Thar Desert, also known as the Great Indian Desert, stretches across Rajasthan and offers a surreal landscape of golden sands and undulating dunes. Rajasthan is a living, breathing testament to India's rich history, vibrant culture, and diverse landscapes.

**Rajasthan's wildlife sanctuaries and national parks** are home to diverse flora and fauna. Ranthambore National Park is located at the junction of the Aravali and Vindhya hill ranges and is one of the finest places in India to view wild animals. The park covers an area of approximately 400 sq km and is famous for its tiger population and is one of the best places in India for tiger sightings. The park's diverse wildlife and picturesque landscapes add to its allure. A huge fort, after which the park is named, towers over the park atop a hill. There are many ruins of bygone eras scattered all over the jungle, which give it a unique, wonderful and mixed flavour of nature, history and wildlife.

The Jhalana Leopard Safari Park is India's 1st Leopard Reserve located in Jaipur. The reserve is spread over an area of 20 square kilometers, with immense flora and fauna present in the park and currently hosts more than 40 leopards and 5 cubs! Other than leopards you can spot striped hyenas, Indian civets, desert cats, jungle cats, desert foxes, jackals, porcupines, jungle rats, monitor lizards, and mongooses, sambar deer, spotted deer (chital), Blue Bull (Nilgai) and a variety of snakes.



### **AISHWARYA SRIDHAR - your wildlife photography instructor**

A National Geographic Explorer, Aishwarya is a Canon EOS Maestro and an Associate Fellow at the International League of Conservation Photographers (iLCP). Aishwarya has contributed photos to several renowned publications like National Geographic magazine, BBC Wildlife, Guardian, Mongabay, Digital Camera, Times of India, Sanctuary Asia among others. In 2020, she became the first Indian woman to win at the Wildlife Photographer of the Year Awards in London. She is the cofounder and CEO of Bambee Studios- a full- service production company in India specialising in natural history and environmental

documentaries for global broadcast. Her productions have been broadcast on leading television networks including National Geographic WILD, Prime Video, Apple TV and Sky TV. Her work has received global recognition in the form of numerous awards and accolades like the Princess Diana Award for young change makers. Her latest directorial "The Fading Star" has earned Aishwarya the prestigious Wildscreen Panda Awards nomination for the 2025 Emerging Talent Award. Through her work, she aims to illuminate critical issues like wildlife trafficking and conservation, inspiring people worldwide to become passionate stewards of our planet. ## Tour Itinerary

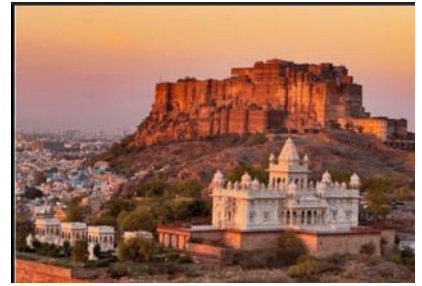
### Day 1: Delhi

Arrive Delhi. Met on arrival and transfer to hotel. Orientation talk and Welcome dinner. Overnight in Delhi.

### Day 2: Delhi to Jodhpur

Flight to Jodhpur and check in to hotel. **Jodhpur**, also called the 'Blue City' was once the capital of the former princely state of Marwar. It was founded in 1459 by Rao Jodha and is now the second largest city of Rajasthan. Flanked on its western side by the Mehrangarh Fort and on the eastern side by the stately sandstone Palace of Umaid Bhawan, the monuments temples and gardens of Jodhpur depict a multi-faceted grandeur. It is still a marvelously medieval city. While the graceful palaces, forts and temples bring alive the historic grandeur, exquisite handicrafts, folk dances, music and the brightly attired people lend a romantic aura to the city.

Overnight in Jodhpur



### Day 3: Jodhpur

Morning after breakfast, enjoy an orientation tour of Jodhpur city. Visit the magnificent **Mehrangarh fort** which dominates the town ringed with its massive protective walls. Continue your tour to **Jaswant Thada**, located a short distance from the fort a white marble memorial to Maharaja Jaswant Singh II built in 1899. Also visit stepwell & local markets in old city. After lunch, you will be taken to the edge of great Thar Desert where a royal desert experience is specially organised for you. Upon arrival at the Camp, you will mount your camel and ride out

through the majestic Thar Desert to experience sunset over the dunes while enjoying sun downers. The **sundowner** is a tradition that was originally introduced by the armed forces of the British East India Company in the early 19th century when soldiers would cap off the day with a gin and tonic as the sun sets beneath the horizon.. We have identified the perfect spot from which to watch the sky turn the most glorious hues of pinks, gold, rose and orange. You will then be transported back to the camp by jeep. Here the bonfires are lit and you will be entertained by traditional Rajasthani musicians and dancers while our chef prepares your BBQ dinner.

Overnight in Jodhpur

### Day 4: Jodhpur to Udaipur

Drive to Udaipur. En-route visit to Ranakpur Jain Temple which is the largest and most significant places of worship for the Jains. This 15th century temple sits gracefully poised on the banks of River Maghai. Featuring intricate designs akin to a fine piece of embroidered cloth, this temple stands as one of the most brilliant architectural monuments on the Indian subcontinent. The Ranakpur temple complex in Rajasthan comprises of 1444 intricately carved pillars, 24 pillared halls accompanied by 80 domes which are borne by 400 columns. The apogee of this entire temple architecture is the fact that no two pillars in here are the same!

In the evening, in Udaipur, you will be transferred to Lok Dharohar for a cultural dance and puppet show.

Overnight in Udaipur.

### Day 5: Udaipur



Romantic, wistful and serene Udaipur - a city built around shimmering, clear blue water lakes which reflect the green hills of the Aravali ranges. The famous lake palaces that seem to emerge from the placid Lake Pichola, whisper the memories of a bygone era. Built in 1567 by Maharana Udai Singh, the city of Udaipur is assimilated around three lakes - Pichola, Fateh Sagar and Uda Sagar. The city was the last capital of Mewar and remained so till the state was merged with the Republic of India in 1947. Begin your day with a visit to City palace a conglomeration of buildings added by various Maharanas; the palace manages to retain a surprising uniformity of design. The entrance is through Hathi Pol (elephant gate) along the main street of the old city, past the Jagdish Temple. The paintings, mosaics, intricately carved 'chhatris' and of course the architecturally

brilliant facade all contribute in making a visit to the City Palace a truly memorable experience. Later visit Sahelion Ki Bari. Followed by Bharatiya Lok Kala folk Museum. Drive past Fateh Sagar Lake. The famous Jagdish Temple is situated 150 mts from the City Palace. This fine Indo-Aryan Temple was constructed by Maharana Jagat Singh in 1651. This temple treasures a black stone image of Lord Vishnu as Jagannath, Lord of the universe. A brass image of Garuda the Hindu divinity is in a monument in front of the temple.

Rest of the afternoon at leisure Overnight in Udaipur

### Day 6: Udaipur to Ranthambore

Drive to Ranthambore. En-route visit Chittorgarh Fort, the largest fort complex in India and a fascinating place to explore. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It rises from the plains like a huge rock island, nearly 6km long and surrounded on all sides by 150m plus cliffs. The imposing fort boasts of well-designed palaces, magnificent cenotaphs and huge towers. The fort of Chittorgarh has a colossal structure that is secured by its several strong gateways. In 1303, the Delhi Sultanate ruler Alauddin Khalji led an army to conquer Chittorgarh, which was ruled by the Guhila king Ratnasimha Legends state that

Alauddin invaded Chittor to capture Ratnasimha's beautiful queen Padmini and that Padmini and other women committed suicide by [jauhar](#) (mass self-immolation).



Dinner at hotel (Beverages own). Overnight in Ranthambore.

#### **Day 7: Ranthambore**

Morning proceed for private game drive into Ranthambore National Park. The morning safaris are usually from sunrise to about 10.00 am. Return to hotel for breakfast. Lunch at hotel (Beverages own). Post lunch, proceed for evening private game drive into Ranthambore National Park. Evening Photography workshop conducted by Aishwarya Sridhar. Optional activity for Non-photographer: You may opt to visit Ranthambore Fort & temple. Ranthambore Fort is nestled deep inside the Ranthambore National Park. The National Park consists of an area which used to be hunting grounds of the erstwhile kings

of Jaipur. Standing atop a hill of 700 ft, the fort is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site under "Hill Forts of Rajasthan". Among the most popular attractions in Ranthambore, the intimidating fort has been pivotal in the history of the state of Rajasthan. Dinner at hotel (Beverages own). Overnight in Ranthambore.

#### **Day 8: Ranthambore**

Morning proceed for private game drive into Ranthambore National Park. The morning safaris are usually from sunrise to about 10.00 am. Return to hotel for breakfast. Lunch at hotel (Beverages own). Post lunch, proceed for evening private game drive into Ranthambore National Park. Evening Photography workshop conducted by Aishwarya Sridhar.

Optional activity for Non-photographer: You may opt to visit Chambal. (Approx 1 hour drive /40 Kms one way). The best way to experience the Chambal Sanctuary is to take a boat safari in Chambal River, experiencing the magnificent Ravines on one side of the bank and happening wildlife on the expanse of the river, the other side. The safari is for one hour (extendable on prorata basis) and your boat escort takes you quite far in to the river bed to experience the natural habitat of Ghariyals, Crocodile, turtles and close to 300 species of resident and migratory birds.

Dinner at hotel (Beverages own). Overnight in Ranthambore.

#### **Day 9: Ranthambore to Jaipur**

Drive to Jaipur and check into hotel. Post lunch proceed for game drive in Jhalana Leopard reserve. Evening photography workshop conducted by Aishwarya Sridhar. Overnight in Jaipur

#### **Day 10: Jaipur**

Morning proceed for Leopard safari in Jhalana Leopard reserve followed by photography workshop conducted by Aishwarya Sridhar. Optional activity for Non-photographers: You may opt a half day city tour and visit Birla temple and Albert Museum. Evening, you will proceed on a specially curated "Bazaar, Crafts & Cuisine walk" with your local guide. This fascinating walking tour help our guests meet locals whilst sampling some of the regions culinary delights; try, samosa, kachori, kulfi and lassi. Sample sweets from some of the city's most popular Mithaiwala's. Observe local artisans like silversmiths, bangle makers, at their workshops. It's a great way to explore the bustling markets and learn about Jaipur's rich art traditions. Walk through a craft market, from wedding card & bangle makers, gold & silver casters and gem stone traders; this market is truly an art lover's delight. Sample a large variety of Indian snacks. Visit an abandoned historic Haveli, decorated with fine frescos which narrate the silent story of its once glorious past. Explore local markets laden with colourful dresses, turban makers, perfume and flower sellers. Overnight in Jaipur.



#### **Day 11: Jaipur**

Visit Amber fort by Elephant one way and return by jeeps. Tour the chambers and hallways of the palace, famous for the excellence of its design and decoration. Within the complex is Ganesh Pol, an imposing gateway painted with the images of the elephant-headed god, Ganesh. After visiting the Fort, visit Panna Mina Step well. This eight-storey step well was built in sixteenth century as a sort of community gathering area and features criss-cross stairs, octagonal gazebos and recessed doorways. According to the local residents of the place, it is impossible for a person to use the same stairs to get down and go upstairs. After lunch visit City Palace and its museum to witness the Maharaja's private collection of textiles and

armoury. Stop at Hawa Mahal also known as the "Palace of the Winds." This beautiful façade is probably the most-photographed in Jaipur, with its ornately carved windows designed so the ladies of the palace could look out onto the streets unobserved.

#### **Day 12: Jaipur**

Day is kept at leisure. Evening visit a famous theatre (Raj Mandir- cinema hall) and enjoy a Bollywood movie.

Overnight in Jaipur.

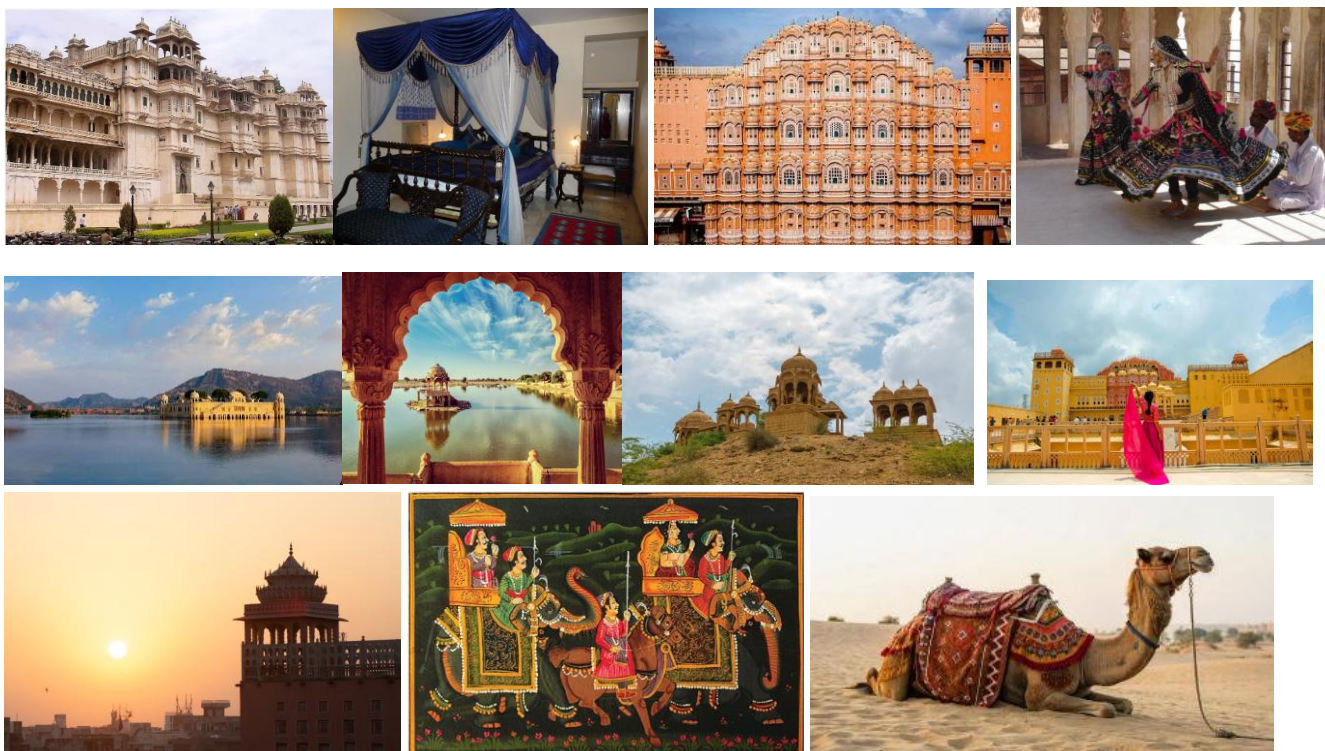
#### **Day 13: Jaipur**

Visit Bagru village famous for its unique block printing, for an exclusive textile experience. First take a village tour visiting different houses where each family is engaged in one of the processes of Block printing. Later, try your own skills to make a beautiful block printed fabric using designer blocks under the supervision of Master artisan. Overnight in Jaipur.

**Day 14: Jaipur to Delhi** Flight to Delhi and transfer to International airport to connect to onward flight back home. If you choose the Delhi- Agra extension option in addition to this tour, you will proceed to hotel in Delhi and check in.
