- Hirers using WAC studios and equipment are expected to acknowledge the Workshop Arts Centre on promotional material of exhibited works.
- Studio hire is for members only. ALL participants must be members.
- Studio hire availability is at the discretion of the WAC.
- Studio hire is for one term (9 weeks). Reservations are made on a first paid basis. Opportunity to hire is available in week 8 of the preceding term. Current hirer's are requested to re hire and pay in week 8 of the current term for the following term's hire. Studio hire during holiday periods is to be arranged in liaison with the office. Studio hire is to be paid in advance.
- Studio Hire fees are non-refundable. Full payment must be made prior to commencement of the term. The Workshop Arts Centre cannot accept responsibility for changes to students' personal circumstances that prevent attendance. No deductions or refunds are available to those who miss hire sessions.
- The WAC has a recommended number of hirers per studio and will accept hire fees to that number. Hirers over and above the recommended number per studio are by arrangement with the confirmed hirers. There is no discount for extra hirers in the space. Hirers must respect other hirers.
- The hire of the space is for the allotted day and time only. Studio hire half day is based on 3 hours of hire. Ensure you clear and vacate the studio at the end of your allocated time.
- Storage space at the WAC is limited and must be hired and paid for separately. When available, open crates and shelf storage are available for hire for \$7 per term and locked storage at \$13 per term.
- Studio Hirer's must provide the office with full contact details and payment for studio hire prior to use. Your contact details will be made available to your hire group unless you tell the office otherwise.
- All Studio Hirer's must sign the register in the front foyer on arrival, and out on departure. As a Hirer you are responsible to return the space clean and tidy; floors swept, equipment stacked and returned and rubbish disposed of in outside garbage bay.
- Hirers must not bring children or guests into studios.
- The Workshop Arts Centre Workplace Health & Safety Policy is available in each studio. All hirer's acknowledge that they are familiar with the relevant Studio Specific Procedures for the studio they are hiring, copies of which are located in each studio along with the location of fire extinguishers, emergency exits and the nearest first aid kit. All studios require covered shoes. Open toed shoes are not permitted.
- All Studio Hirer's must follow workplace procedures and instructions provided by the Workshop Arts Centre. Workplace Health & Safety manuals, along with studio procedures are located in marked locations in each studio.
- The use of equipment provided by the Workshop Arts Centre in the studios will be subject to the hirer providing evidence of WAC annual training and WAC teacher approval. All electrical equipment used must be tagged and tested annually.
- Painting Studio Hirers must have completed or be attending a painting course at the Workshop Arts Centre and/or be approved by a WAC teacher.
- Sculpture Studio Hirers must have completed or be attending a sculpture course at the Workshop Arts Centre and/or be approved by a WAC teacher.
- Print Studio Hirers must have completed or be attending a printmaking course at the Workshop Arts Centre and/ or be approved by a WAC teacher.
