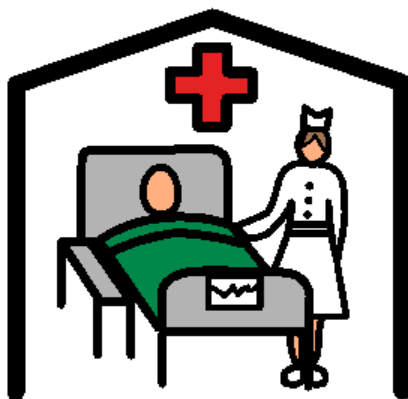


Blood Tests

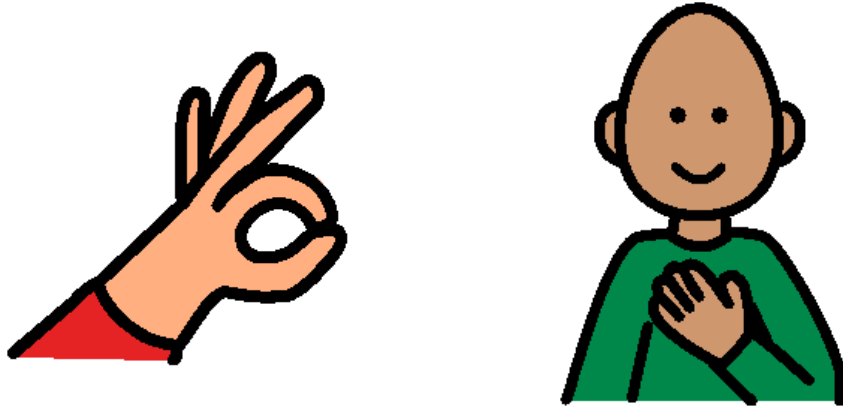
Sometimes I get sick or hurt.

or to see a doctor.

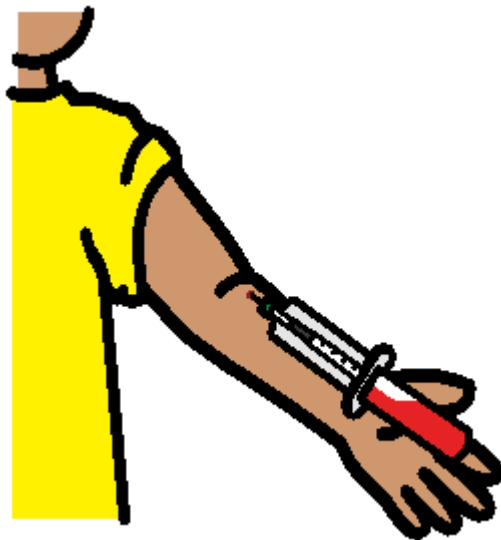


This is okay because the doctor can help me feel better.

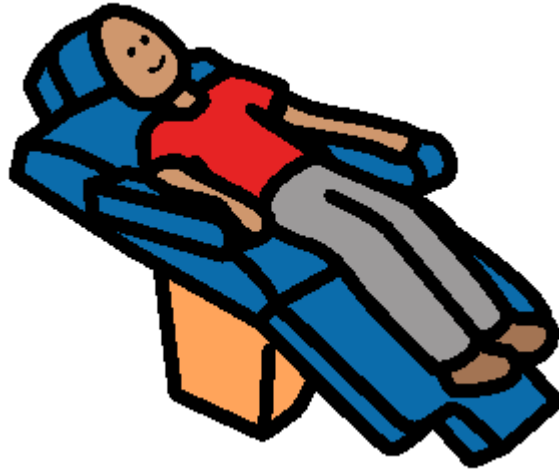


The doctor may have to look at my blood to see if I'm ok.

To do this, the doctor may need to put a small needle in my arm.



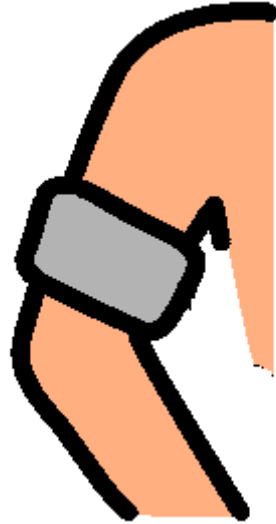
I will need to sit or lie still on the hospital bed.

The doctor will clean my arm with a cold wipe.



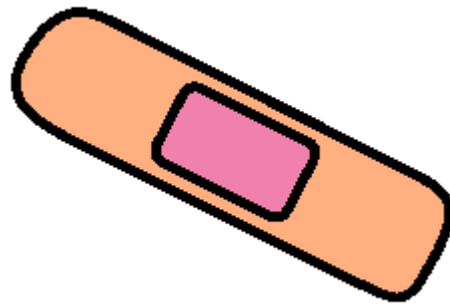
The doctor will carefully put a needle in my arm. I will feel a sharp scratch. This is okay, because it won't last long.
