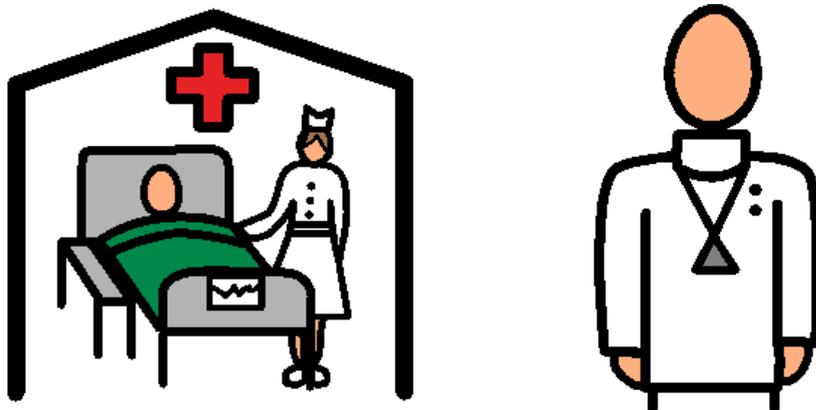


Getting an CT Scan


Sometimes I get sick or hurt.




When this happens, I might go to the hospital so a doctor can look at me.

To do this, the doctor may need a special way to take pictures of my body parts called a CT scan.




I will need to change into a special hospital gown first.
