

How Spare Parts Puppet Theatre is working to keep you safe during COVID-19

Hygiene and the safety of our staff, volunteers and guest is top priority, so here's what we're doing to help keep us all safe and how you can help:

- Cashless transactions are preferred via our online booking system or in person at our box office.
- To assist with contact tracing, all tickets will require the name of the ticket holder as part of the booking process.
- Download SafeWA app <https://www.wa.gov.au/organisation/covid-communications/covid-19-coronavirus-safewa> – We encourage you download the app prior to attending the theatre for quicker check in.
- We have a QR code so using the SafeWA app for contact tracing is easy and convenient. We do also have a manual sign in register if necessary.
- Our doors open 1 hour prior to a performance time, so please arrive early and enjoy our new spacious the foyer and leave plenty of time to find a seat in the theatre.
- We have increased our cleaning, with high touch surfaces disinfected between each performance.
- We ask that you do not attend if you are unwell or have been asked to isolate. Please call 9335 5044 to arrange an exchange, refund or to donate the cost of your tickets.
- All our staff and volunteers have completed the AHA Hospitality and Tourism COVID-19 Hygiene Training Course
- We are working at a reduced capacity of 60%, giving you peace of mind that you will be able to distance yourself in the theatre: keeping apart is the friendly way to be!
- We have retired our re-usable wristband system for the duration of COVID-19.
- Our new creative learning centre contains hands on exhibits specifically designed for ease of cleaning, which is done during performances.
- We have sanitiser conveniently located within the theatre for ease of access
