

SPARE PARTS PUPPET THEATRE DESIGN-A-PUPPET COMPETITION

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The promoter is: Spare Parts Puppet Theatre whose registered office is at 1 Short Street, Fremantle WA 6160.
2. Employees of Spare Parts Puppet Theatre, Lotterywest or their family members or anyone else connected in any way with the competition or helping to set up the competition shall not be permitted to enter the competition.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
4. Route to entry for the competition and details of how to enter are via the Spare Parts Puppet Theatre website (www.sppt.asn.au).
5. Closing date for entry will be 4:00pm (AWST) 20 August 2021. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
6. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received.
7. The rules of the competition and the prize for the winner are as follows; Entrants must reside in Western Australia as at the closing date for entries. Only one entry per applicant will be accepted. Parents and guardians are to enter via the website and give permission for applicants under 18 years to enter the competition.

One design will be selected to be professionally constructed and showcased as part of Spare Parts Puppet Theatre's 40th year Community Celebration on November 6, 2021 to be held in Pioneer Park, Fremantle. If no suitable design is submitted, the promoter is not obligated to select a winning design brief.

The chosen design entrant, along with two other selected entrants, will each receive a Design-a-Puppet prize pack including a family pass (four tickets) to see **The one Who Planted Trees** at Spare Parts Puppet Theatre in September 2021.

8. The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.

9. The promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
10. No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability, and we reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
11. Chance plays no part in determining the winner. Each entry will be individually judged, based upon individual creative merit following the assessment matrix supplied. All entries must be an independent creation by the entrant and free of any claims that infringe any third-party rights.

The judges reserve the right to disqualify any entrant submitting an entry which, in the opinion of the judges, includes objectionable content, including but not limited to profanity, nudity, potentially insulting, scandalous, inflammatory or defamatory images or language. The judges' decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. All entries become and remain the property of the promoter and agencies associated with this promotion (Spare Parts Puppet Theatre and Lotterywest). By entering this competition, you give permission for Spare Parts Puppet Theatre and Lotterywest to share your entry on their respective Facebook page and other social media channels. Spare Parts Puppet Theatre and/or Lotterywest may use the entrant's name(s) and the submitted entry for future promotional marketing and publicity purposes.
14. Winners (3) will be chosen by panel selection from all entries received. One Spare Parts Puppet Theatre representative and one Lotterywest representative will make up the panel. The panel will judge the entries on how well they meet the criteria using the following assessment matrix:
 - a) **Concept:** How well the creative brief relates to the 'my community' theme (40%)
 - b) **Expression:** How imaginatively the creative brief conveys an idea or emotion, or incorporates a specific story about your community (40%)
 - c) **Composition and style:** How well the different elements of the creative brief work together to convey the theme. (20%)
15. The winner(s) will be notified by email and/or phone within 14 days of the closing date. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 2 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.
16. The promoter will notify the winner(s) when and where the prize can be collected.
17. The promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
