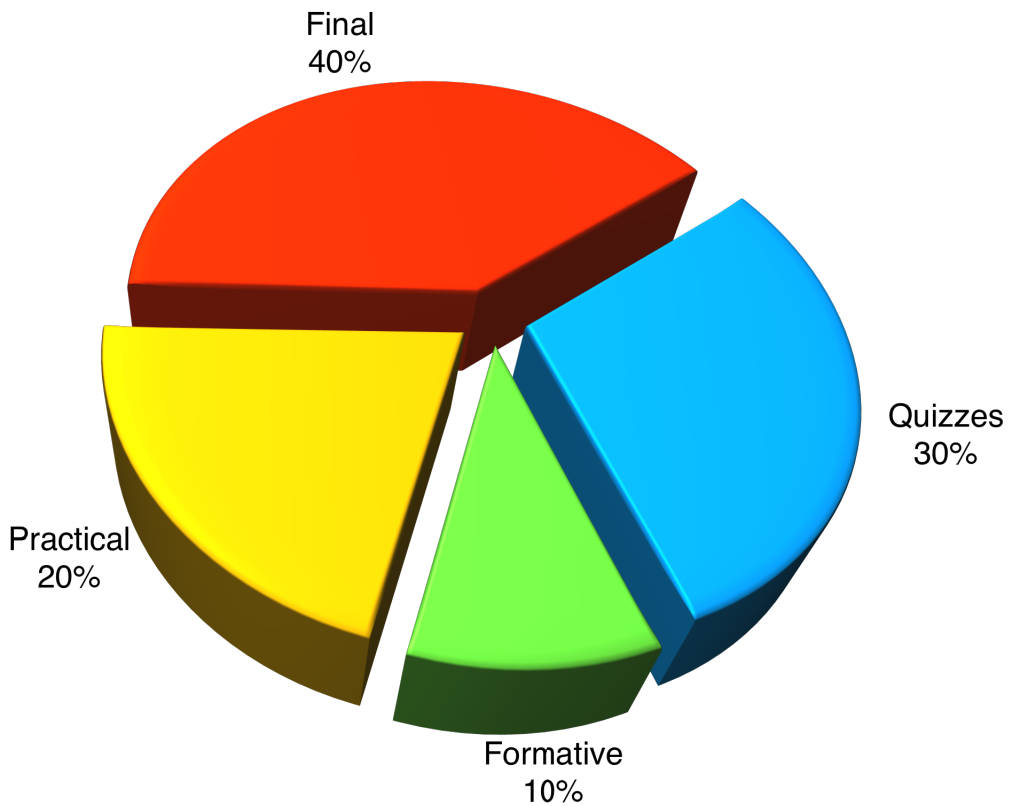


This is the assessment scheme for Digital Sub-Systems. The pass mark overall is 70% and the quizzes and final theory assessment are must pass, so you need grades better than 50% in quizzes and grade 70% in final exam. Practical assessment is more flexible, as components may fail, boards may fail etc, but you must demonstrate to your assessor that you know exactly what you are doing in a competent manner to achieve a satisfactory mark of more than 50%. Any practical assignments allocated will form part of your 20% overall, with in class work and practical assessments making up the difference.

Homework given will be checked and may form part of the 30% quiz marks.
