## Running lessons with your class

### Setting up your class:

- Add class students to the platform. This can be achieved with the 'Student' button, or by sending your class list to <u>support@lifeskillsgroup.com.au</u>

- 1. If students are using their own devices, first distribute their usernames & passwords, visible from the 'Student' button.
