On 29 April 2019, I examined the filly at Kolora Lodge, Waterford Qld

Clinical: The filly was clinically examined, walked and trotted at Kolora Lodge, Waterford, QLD on the 29 April 2019, with no significant abnormalities. She appeared in good health and condition. No abnormalities were detected on auscultation of the heart and lungs. No abnormalities were detected on manipulation and palpation of the legs and joints. No response to hoof testers was found. There was no evidence of lameness at the trot and the horse moved freely.

No electrocardiography, endoscopy or radiographs were requested or performed.

In my opinion, based on these findings, the filly is suitable to be a racing proposition.
