INFORMATION

To assist in the smooth running of this convention please read the following information carefully.

OUT OF BOUNDS	The Riverside Adventist School grounds are strictly out of bounds except for the Primary Division during their program. Please keep children off all garden areas and take note of the out of bounds area shown on the back page.
FIRST AID	Security has a basic first-aid kit and all teachers have a first aid certificate. Bulk billed medical consultations are offered to campers at Rosslea Medical Centre, 112 Bowen Road (corner of Viles Road), Rosslea. Phone 4758 0500 for an appointment or visit the Townsville Hospital Emergency Department, 100 Angus Smith Drive, Douglas (07 4796 1111). In emergencies ring 000 for an ambulance.
FIRE SAFETY	Take extreme care when using gas appliances in tents. Fire extinguishers are located beside tents clearly marked with a red sign. Refer to map on back page. Please take note of the closest fire extinguisher to your tent. In case of fire, vacate the area immediately, use the fire extinguisher and contact Camp Superintendent or security. In an emergency dial 000 for the fire brigade.
CHILD SAFETY	It is essential that parents do not simply assume that their children are safe. Parents need to know at all times, where their children are, what they are doing, and maintain responsibility for their supervision and safety AT ALL TIMES.

SECURITY	Security office is located under the high school-hall. Please do not leave valuables unsecured in tents or vans.
LOST PROPERTY	All lost property should be delivered to the camp office. Check for your lost property there. Anything not claimed will be disposed of after camp.
MOBILE PHONES	Mobile Phones can be left with security under the high school-hall to be charged.
PRIVATE BUSINESS	Campers and other visitors are requested not to distribute, sell or canvas anything unless authorised to do so by Conference Administration or the Camp Superintendent.

CAMP SITES	Approval is needed prior to camping. Those sleeping on the grounds must be registered campers. Young people under 18 are not permitted to camp overnight without adequate adult supervision.
WHO IS WHERE	Camp Map will be located at security with a list of campers staying on the grounds and their site number.
ATMOSPHERE	It is expected that the attitudes and behaviours of campers are appropriate for a Christian Convention. Loud and offensive language is not expected and will not be tolerated. Offenders may be required to leave the grounds. Any electronic music device or other instrument must be used in a manner so as not to cause annoyance to neighbours in adjoining sites.
NOISE CURFEW	Between 10:30 pm and 6:30 am we ask that there be NO NOISE made that could affect the sleep of neighbours or other campers.

VEHICLE ACCESS	No parking of vehicles is allowed in tent accommodation access roads. Parking is to be only in designated parking areas. Vehicles will only be briefly permitted in tent access roads on Friday June 29, and Sunday July 8 for unloading / loading of camp equipment. Do not block access to large rubbish bins with your vehicle.
SPEED LIMIT	10 km per hour AT ALL TIMES, give way to pedestrians.
BICYCLES	NO bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, skates, push scooters, motorbikes or similar are to be used on the campground. Camp is pedestrian priority territory!
GARBAGE **	Please wrap all rubbish in paper or put into cartons or plastic bags before placing in large garbage containers. Keep the grounds around your tent or caravan free from rubbish.
WASHING DISHES	Food dishes and cooking utensils are not to be washed in the laundry. For your convenience washing-up sinks are located at the back of the camp kitchen and the end of the cabin amenities block.
SHOWERS	To conserve hot water PLEASE keep showers brief. It would be appreciated if parents could ensure that children shower as quickly as possible. Baby bath sinks available in back right toilet block
LAUNDRY	Situated in two amenities blocks. Coin operated washing machines (3x \$1 coins needed)
ANIMALS	NO PETS are allowed on the campgrounds.

Camp Demolition Procedures

Refunds will be available from the furniture shed on Saturday night and Sunday morning. People leaving earlier will need to make arrangements with camp superintendent for refunds. No refunds will be given during Sabbath hours (Friday 6:00pm - Saturday 6:00pm).

SATURDAY NIGHT

- Chairs in all divisions are to be stacked at the conclusion of the last meeting. Hired chairs and tables should be stacked together outside the big tent and chairs from the Youth Hall returned there and stacked.
- Stages are to be dismantled and equipment packed away under departmental direction.

SUNDAY MORNING

- Please vacate your tents as soon as possible.
- Return mattress to underneath the hall and all furniture to the Big Shed to claim the furniture deposit refund. No deposits will be refunded without all items returned.
- Please keep mattresses clean and off the ground at all times. Having mattresses on a tarp is not off the ground as the mattresses get mouldy.
- When your tent is empty, please undo all velcro on inside poles, close windows and untie all outside ropes.
- Park to load so roadways are clear at all times for free traffic flow.
- Remove vehicles from camping area as soon as possible.

Keynote Speaker Lee Venden


has never forgotten the joy he experienced when he discovered the difference between knowing about Jesus and actually knowing Jesus. A pastor and educator for more


