



## The National Disability Insurance Scheme is coming to the Western Adelaide region.

### What is the National Disability Insurance Scheme?

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is a new way of delivering services and support for people with permanent and significant disability in Australia.

With the NDIS, people with disability can choose supports and services to meet their individual needs, rather than have to fit into a one-size-fits-all system.

### When will the NDIS begin?

If you are already receiving disability services you will continue with your existing supports until you transition to the NDIS.

The Western Adelaide region consists of the following local council areas:

- Charles Sturt
- Port Adelaide Enfield (West)
- West Torrens
