The National Disability Insurance Scheme is coming to the Murray and Mallee.

What is the National Disability Insurance Scheme?

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is a new way of delivering services and support for people with permanent and significant disability in Australia.

With the NDIS, people with disability can choose supports and services to meet their individual needs, rather than have to fit into a one-size-fits-all system.

**The NDIS will begin to roll
out for people aged 18 to
64 in the Murray and Mallee
from 1 October 2017.**

When will the NDIS begin?

If you are already receiving disability services you will continue with your existing supports until you transition to the NDIS.

The Murray and Mallee region consists of the following local council areas:

- Karoonda East Murray Council
- Mid Murray Council
- Rural City of Murray Bridge
- Southern Mallee District Council
- Coorong District Council
- Berri Barmera Council
- Loxton Waikerie Council
