## Frequently Asked Questions



### **When and where are the 2015 State Championships being held?**

Saturday 6 June, Sunday 7 June & Monday 8 June 2015

### **Open, 21U, 17U, Over 35, Over 40 & Over 45 Divisions**

Hosted by Illawarra District Netball Association  
Hooka Creek Road, Berkeley

### **Once my team has entered its team list can we de-register or late-register players?**

Yes, this can only be done at Event Control prior to 8am on Day 1 of State Championships (Saturday 6 June 2015). A team may register a maximum of four (4) late registrations. Deregistration of players is also permitted at this time. However following the close of entries, players listed on an original team registration form are not permitted to de-register and re-register with another Association. A team must still consist of a maximum of twelve (12) players.

### **What time does Event Control open on day 1 of State Championships?**

7.30am.

### **What is the cost to enter a team?**

\$242 (includes GST).

### **When is the draw available?**

The draw will be uploaded to the State Championships page of the Netball NSW Website by COB Monday 1 June 2015.

### **When are results available?**

**Results Board** – These are located outside Event Control and will be updated shortly after the completion of each round. Please note that for the last 3 rounds of each division results will not be shown on the results board.

**Netball NSW website** – individual game results, ladders and news will be available on the State Championships page of the Netball NSW website, netballnsw.com. These will be updated during the day but results will not be official until they have been checked and verified approx. 2 hours after the completion of each day's play. Note: further changes could be made by Netball NSW after the conclusion of the competition.

### **Will Netball NSW have a State Championships App this year?**

In 2015, the NSW netball community will be able to access the State Championships fixture and results online via the 2015 State Championships page at netballnsw.com.

A key function of the new Netball NSW website launched in November 2013 is its mobile and tablet compatibility. Please refer to the above section, "when are results available", for further details pertaining to the publishing of results.

### **Does each team get a team bag?**

Yes, each team can collect their team bag, which includes important information from Event Control on Day 1 of State Championships.

### **What parking is available at each of the State Championships venues?**

The Players Village and Parent Tent Area cannot be accessed prior to 6am on day 1 of the State Championships. Absolutely no cooking/heating of food or drinks is permitted either inside or near the Players Tent Area. Cooking is permitted in the Parent Tent Area but this must be done a distance of 2 metres from tents but still within the Parent Tent Area. Further information can be found on the Players Village Map which can be downloaded from the State Championships page of the Netball NSW website.

### **Is there ice available to purchase?**

Ice is not available to purchase from the venues. There are service stations nearby to the venue where ice can be purchased.

### **Does Netball NSW provide First Aid services at the venue?**

Yes, Netball NSW provides trained Medics at the State Championships venue. The Medics will be located near Event Control.

### **What happens if there is inclement weather?**

In the case of inclement weather, a decision shall be made at 7.30am, each morning whether play will commence for the day.

### **When are winners from each division known?**

Winner and runners up from each division are awarded their trophy and patches at the Presentation Ceremony at the conclusion of the State Championships. This will commence once all results have been confirmed.

### **What is the length of a game?**

Games will consist of 2 x 13 minute halves, 1 minute half time and 2 minutes between rounds.

### **What are the start times for each day of the Championships?**

### **What points are awarded for games?**

There are zero (0) points awarded for a bye.

There are zero (0) points awarded for a loss.

There are two (2) points awarded for a win.

If games are called off due to weather, teams are awarded one (1) point each for the games which did not take place, however no points are awarded for a BYE.

For games stopped prior to half time, each team are awarded one (1) point each. Should games be stopped after half time, the score stands as per the score sheet at time of stoppage.

Should a team withdraw from competition prior to the commencement of Day 1 – zero (0) points are awarded.

Should a team withdraw after competition commences, the opposing team will be awarded 2 points as a forfeit win.

### **Is my Association required to provide umpires?**

Yes, each Association must provide 1 umpire for each team they have entered.

### **If our umpire is sick what do we do?**

Please advise Umpire Control as soon as possible.

When an umpire withdraws on any day of the Championships, for other than medical reasons, extenuating circumstances or does not show, that association will incur a \$200 fine, per allocation, per day.

Medical certificates are required for any umpires that pull out due to injury or illness between now and the end of the Championships.
