Role Outline: Sydney Netball Academy – Assistant and Apprentice Coaches

The Sydney Netball Academy Program is run by Netball NSW. It is one of twelve academies throughout the state. The other Academies are run by Regional Academies of Sport (RASi) or Office of Sport.

The focus of the program is growth for athletes (14-16 years of age) and for coaches that show the potential and desire to progress in the Emerging Talent Athlete and Coach Pathway.

Assistant and Apprentice coaches of the Sydney Netball Academy Program will:

- Assist with selection of 48 athletes at trials in October.
- Assist to create a positive culture
- Be committed to the principles of long-term athlete development and athlete centred coaching
- Provide effective feedback to athletes to maximise technical and tactical growth
- Be available for 12 Friday night sessions from January-April and July-October.
- Attend the High Performance Camp (February) Academy Games (April) and Academy Challenge (October)

Assistant and Apprentice Coach Roles at Sydney Netball Academy provide the perfect challenge for coaches that display talent and have a desire to grow.

Coaches will be supported throughout the program with regular education sessions and mentoring.
