Applicants must have strong technical, tactical and communication skills and should be able to demonstrate an aptitude and commitment to progress in Pathway Coaching when opportunities present.

Assistant and Apprentice coaches will be supported throughout the campaign with education sessions and mentoring and will benefit from regular collaboration within the State Team Coach Group.

Applicants should have a minimum Netball Australia Intermediate Coach Accreditation.
