Netball WA members are aligned to the leading State Sporting Association providing support to build capacity of local communities to deliver netball at a community and Club level whilst providing pathways for all players, coaches, officials and volunteers. In order to participate in a Netball WA affiliated Association competition or development courses and pathways, all players; coaches and officials must be a member of Netball WA through registering directly with a Region, Association or Club.

Netball WA is committed to the delivery of our strategic plan and our key purposes of:

- Providing access to netball in Western Australia;
- Growing participation and engagement in the sport;
- Being a leader in the sport industry; and
- Empowering our communities.

Netball WA prioritises the following key objectives to provide ongoing support to our Regions, Associations and Clubs. These priorities will also allow for the continued capacity building and empowerment of our people and communities. These include:

- The continuation of MyNetball education, training and development to Regions, Associations, Clubs and NetSetGO Centres;
- The implementation of Strategic Facility priorities, allowing the development of Netball WA's Strategic Facilities plan (released in November 2015);
- Region, Association and Club Planning, Volunteer Management, Governance and Policy implementation and support (specifically across Child Protection, Member Protection and Working with Children Check) and incorporation;
- Coach, Umpire and Official education and training, including the delivery of Mental Health and Inclusion Workshops;
- Delivery of key whole of sport projects including the creation, member engagement and analysis of a Netball WA Census and Governance and Membership Review.

Key benefits of membership include:

- **Netball Australia Capitation Fee:** Netball WA remits a fixed amount for each member to Netball Australia.
- **Insurance:** all Netball WA affiliated members (those registered under either a Senior, Junior, Non-Playing membership type, appropriately recorded Volunteer or also ANZ NetSetGO participant) are protected by Willis Insurance which includes Personal Accident, Public Liability/Professional Indemnity, Association Liability, Property;
- **Events:** contributes to fundamental events in the netball calendar, such as the Netball WA AGM conference, Smarter than Smoking WA Netball League, Smarter than Smoking Association Championships, Academy Cup, Game Development Conference, West Coast Fever matches and Netball WA Annual Dinner;
- **Marketing:** direct communication to members through the Netball WA website, e-newsletters, social media and other communication.
