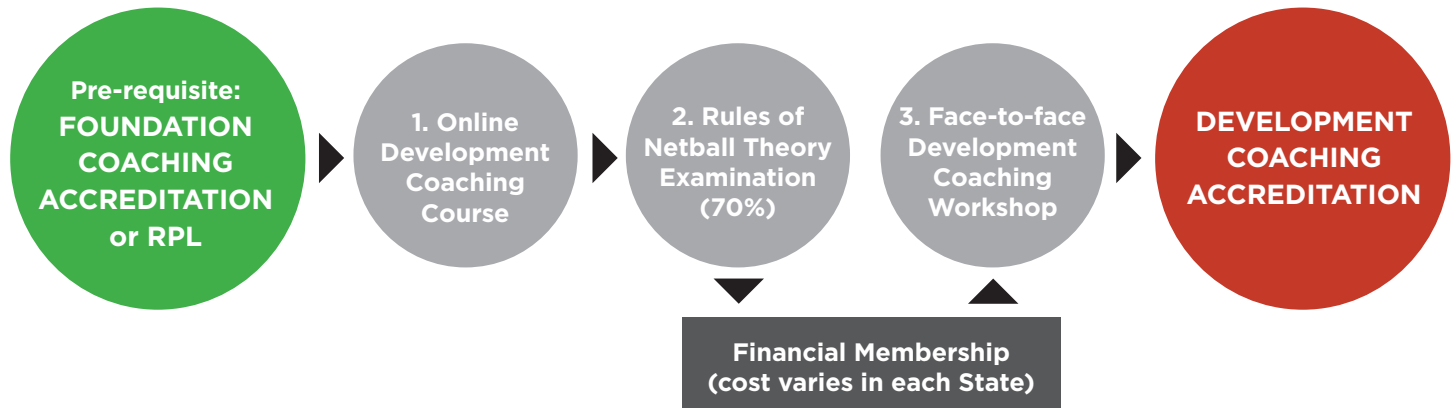


BLENDDED LEARNING DEVELOPMENT COACH ACCREDITATION COMING IN 2017!



About the course

The blended learning (online and face-to-face) Development Coach Accreditation Course is targeted primarily at Club, Association and Regional coaches and teachers aiming to further their netball knowledge. The Course is the second step in the national coaching accreditation framework and provides a good introduction to skill progression and fault detection and correction.

What are the benefits of moving to a blended course?

- Initial learning online in a self-paced environment at a time and place that suits the learner.
- Videos of experienced coaches teaching development level skills and activities.
- Downloadable session plans from the online course.
- ‘Flipped classroom’ delivery with coaches learning ‘what’ to coach online and practicing ‘how’ to coach at the 4-hour face-to-face workshop.
- Face-to-face delivery coach centred rather than presenter driven.

What are the requirements of the new blended course?

1. Completion of the online Development Coach Accreditation component.
2. Completion of the online Rules of Netball Theory Exam (70% pass).
3. Completion of the 4-hour face-to-face workshop.

NB: Coaches must complete 1 and 2 above and be a financial member before proceeding to 3.

What will participants receive at the end of the course?

Upon successful completion of all modules, participants will receive their Development Coach Accreditation and certificate of completion.

How much will the course cost?

The online Development Coach Accreditation course will cost participants \$50.00 (inclusive of GST) to enroll in through MyNetball.

The online rules of netball exam is free of charge.

The face-to-face Development Coach Accreditation workshop fee and financial membership will be determined and managed by each State Member Organisation.

All payments will be managed online through a secure gateway.

Will participants receive the Development Coaching Manual?

Yes. Participants will receive the manual at the Face-to-Face Workshop. The cost of the manual is included in the workshop fee.

Will there be a time limit on completing the course?

Yes. Coaches will have 12 months to complete all three components of the course. Participants can log in and out of the online course as required and can enroll in a face-to-face workshop through the MyNetball Learning portal.

Will participants be able to access the course materials after they have completed the online course?

Yes. Upon successful completion of all online modules, participants will be able to log back into the system and access the materials.

When will the course be available?

The course will be available for enrolments in February 2017.
