- Assisting Regions, Associations and Clubs to have effective governance models, systems and procedures.
- Assisting Regions, Associations and Clubs to have strategic/operational plans in place.
- Establishing one brand across the sport in Western Australia.
- Growing relationships with all Netball providers including indoor centres, schools and others.
- Development and delivery of volunteer workforce development programs.
- Management of the Smarter than Smoking WA Netball League.
- Inclusion programs (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander, Multi-Cultural and Disabilities).
- Ensuring clean and transparent communication systems are in place and used across the whole of the sport.
- Facilitating the effective use of technology at state, region, association and club level.
- Driving the evolution of Netball in WA, removing barriers to participation.

Regions
