There is an identified need to increase our efforts to support and engage Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander players, coaches, umpires, volunteers, their families and communities. After the successful implementation of Netball Australia's Reconciliation Plan (RAP) in 2015, Netball South launched its own Innovative RAP in September, 2017.

The Netball SA RAP Advisory Group will consist of 7 members, consisting of one representative from SA Nunga Netball, one representative from SAASTA and the remaining 5 members being Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander members, or representatives of organisations working with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. Netball SA is responsible for appointing all members of the RAP Advisory Group and determining the process of appointments.
