The **Social Netball** Competition is conducted under the authority of Netball Queensland (NQ). The Competition will be played out of the brand-new Queensland State Netball Centre (QSNC) – the home of NQ and the Queensland Firebirds.

The Competition aims to provide Women's and Mixed teams the opportunity to play socially amongst friends or together within a higher division suited to your competitive expectations. It caters for a wide range of ages from 15 years and all skill levels are encouraged to join.

The teams are graded accordingly, and games will be played weekly with the option of a Monday night and/or Wednesday night Competition. This concludes with a Finals series where the top 4 teams of each Division play off.

Once the QSNC is fully up and running, NQ will consider offering Social Netball opportunities on additional day/s of the week. Keep an eye out on your NQ Social Netball Team App or NQ Facebook.

SECTION 1: INTRODUCTION

Purpose of this Manual

- The aim of this Competition Manual is to provide players with a clear and concise framework under which the Social Netball Competition is conducted by Netball Queensland (NQ).

Competition Conditions

- Games will be played and umpired under the official *International Netball Federation* (INF) “Rules of Netball” 2018 Edition and set by NQ.
- It is the responsibility of the **Team Contact** to ensure that team members are fully aware of the Rules of Netball as well as the information written in this Competition Manual.
- Any alterations to the official Rules of Netball and applied to Social Netball Competitions are specified in this Competition Manual.
- NQ have the right to change and update any ruling within this Competition Manual to ensure the best possible competition for its members.
- Any changes to these conditions will be communicated to umpires and players in a timely manner prior to implementation.
- These conditions will apply to both Women’s and Mixed Social Netball Competitions and across all divisions.



SECTION 2: GENERAL INFORMATION

Competition Outline

- Season 1 2019, Social Netball Competition will comprise of the following competition nights.

Monday Night	Women's
Wednesday Night	Women's
	Mixed

- The number of Divisions per night will be dependent on team nominations and level of performance during grading.
- The Mixed Competition will be run separately to the Women's Competition and be played on Wednesday night. However the competition will be dependent on number of teams nominated.
- Teams must consist of a minimum of seven (7) players.
- The minimum playing age for both Women's and Mixed Competitions is 15 years of age. Players turning 15 years of age in the calendar year of the Competition are eligible to play.
- Players can only play for the team they are registered in.
- They will NOT be permitted to fill in for another team in the same competition on the same night (i.e. two Monday Women's Teams).
- Players can play on multiple nights (Monday and Wednesday team) or in both the Women's and Mixed competition so long as they are registered separately for each team.

Venue Information

- The Social Netball Competition will be played at two (2) locations.
- The Monday Competition season will begin the season at Hibiscus Stadium.

- The Monday competition will then be moved to the new Queensland State Netball Centre (QSNC) once construction of this venue is complete. The remainder of the season will be played out of QSNC. Teams will be notified of this venue change.

- Due to venue restrictions the Wednesday Competition will not be played at Hibiscus Stadium.
- The Wednesday Competition will begin later in February once the construction of the new QSNC is complete. The full Wednesday season will be played at QSNC.
- Parking will be available at both venues for players and spectators.

Team Contact

- Teams must have one designated **Team Contact** for the season.
- Team Contact must be 18yrs or over.
- They are the Primary Contact for all on and off-court matters for their team.
- The Team Contact responsibilities also include;
 - Conducting the initial team nomination through MyNetball.
 - Ensuring team fees are paid in full by the due date.
 - ALL players (including themselves) are registered through MyNetball by the due date.
 - ALL players have played the minimal number of games to qualify for finals.
 - ALL players meet the age requirements as per the competition conditions.
 - ALL players acknowledge and abide by competition conditions as outlined in this Manual as well as NQ Codes of Behaviour.
 - ALL players are informed of game times and/or game changes.

Team Communication

- The Competition Coordinator will direct all communication to the Team Contact via email and/or phone.
- Information regarding draws, byes, forfeits and season dates will be communicated with all players through the ['2019 Social Netball' Team App](#) (free to download and join).
- All relevant documents including this Competition Manual can be accessed on Team App.
- Inappropriate, condemning and/or unwanted content WILL NOT be tolerated. Netball Queensland has the right to remove any member from Team App if he/she communicates within this manner.

SECTION 3: COMPETITION FORMAT

Competition Dates:

Due to venue restrictions Monday Competition will start **3 weeks** prior to the Wednesday Competition. Wednesday Competition will result in a smaller season which will be reflected in total fees on team's invoices.

Game Format

- 20 minute halves with a 2 minute break between halves.
- 3 minutes between games.
- Format will remain the same for all grading, season fixture and finals games.

1 st Half	Half Time Interval	2 nd Half	Interval between games
20 minutes	2 minutes	20 minutes	3 minutes

- A ball for each game will be supplied by NQ.
- Umpires for each game will be supplied by NQ

Game Times

- Games will be run at the following timeslots:
 - 6:15PM – 7:00PM
 - 7:00PM – 7:45PM
 - 7:45PM – 8:30PM
 - 8:30PM – 9:15PM
- During Finals Series these times will change to allow for drawn games to be played out.

Grading Rounds, BYEs and Draw

Grading

- A grading draw will be available prior to commencement of the competition.
- Grading will occur after the first 3 weeks of the competition.
- Teams will be able to nominate a preferred and appropriate division in which they wish to play in.
- Teams are not guaranteed to be placed in their preferred divisions. The Competitions Coordinator will consider team preferences as well as teams performance during the grading games in order to grade each team appropriately in the context of the competition.
- Teams can request a regrade, however this should be done no later than 48hours BEFORE Round 1 fixture. Requests after this time will not be considered.
- NQ reserves the right to refuse and/or alter grades at any point throughout the season.



Byes

- NQ cannot guarantee an even number of teams across all grades and divisions. As a result byes may be necessary to fulfil the draw.

Draw and Ladder

- The full season draw will be made available after the 3rd grading round and prior to the Round 1 fixture.
- The season draw and premiership ladder will be available online at www.mynetball.com.au using the player's login details. It will also be made available for players using the MyNetball App and Team App.
- The following points system will be used during the Grading games as well as the regular season fixtures:

Win	= 2 pts
Loss	= 0 pts
Draw	= 1 pts
Bye	= 0 pts
Forfeit Loss*	= 0 pts
Forfeit Win	= 2 pts

*subject to the nature of the forfeit see *Forfeits* for further details

- Grading points will NOT be carried over to the regular season fixtures.

Withdrawals

- Any team who withdraws after the release of the initial grading draw are liable to pay the full balance of their remaining competition fees or if already have done so they will not receive any refund for competition fees.
- Draws and ladders will be appropriately adjusted by the discretion of NQ for any team who is withdrawn from the competition by choice or by expulsion.

Forfeits

- To take the court a minimum of five (5) players are required.
- The Mixed Competition must have a minimum of five (5) players including one (1) male.
- If a team fails to have 5 players on court by the start of the game, the opposition will be awarded one (1) goal for every full minute that elapses until the minimum player requirement is met.
- If after ten (10) minutes the team cannot meet the minimum of five (5) players they will forfeit the game. The offending team will be penalized



with an Extreme Late Forfeit.

- If a team needs to forfeit their game they **MUST** contact the Competitions Coordinator.
- The following Forfeit penalties will apply:

Early forfeit	BEFORE 3pm on the day of the scheduled game will receive no competition points.
Late forfeit	AFTER 3pm on the day of the scheduled game will be deducted two (2) competition points.
Extreme Late forfeit	Without notice or within (1) hour before the scheduled game – Will be deducted two (2) competition points and fined \$100

- The offending team cannot take the court until the forfeit fee is paid.
- Teams given the Extreme Late Forfeit penalty more than 3 times will be removed from the competition and will not receive any refund on competition fees.

Finals Series

Finals Format

- The Finals Series will be played after the conclusion of the regular season fixtures.
- The top four (4) teams with the most competition points in each division will compete in the final series.
- If teams are tied for competition points, the finals positions will be determined using the following steps:
 - Team with the highest goal percentage during the regular season rounds (goals for divided by goals against multiplied by 100).
 - If teams are still tied:
 - Team in whom won the match between the 2 teams concerned during their last fixture round.
 - If teams are still tied:
 - Team with the better For and Against (the difference between goals for and goals against)
 - If teams are still tied:
 - Most Goals during the full regular season rounds
- The format for each division's final series is as follows:

Semi Final 1	1 st vs 4 th
Semi Final 2	2 nd vs 3 rd
Grand Final	Winner SF1 vs Winner SF2



- The draw for the finals series will be determined at the conclusion of the regular fixtures.
- NQ has the right to alter Finals format to best suit the competition needs.
- A team may make themselves unavailable for finals however they must do so before the finals draw has been released.
- If a team does withdraw from finals before the draw is released a subsequent team below them on the ladder can be made available to take their place.
- If a team withdraws after the finals draw has been released the team in which they were planned to play will win on forfeit and automatically move through to the next Finals round.

Finals Eligibility

- Players must be registered through MyNetball and listed on the team sheet.
- Players must have played a minimum of 5 games for that team during the season.
- Players will be required to sign on with Photo ID for the Finals Series.

Drawn Finals Games

- In the event of a draw during the finals series the following will take place
 - At the completion of regular time there will be a one (1) minute break
 - After the one (1) minute break, teams change ends and two (2) halves of five (5) minutes extra time will be played.
 - After the first five (5) minute half teams will change ends and continue their 2nd (5) minute half with no break.
- If the game is still drawn at the end of the 2nd five (5) minute half, play continues until one team gains a two (2) goal advantage.
- Substitutions during extra time are permitted.

Awards

- Presentations for the Winners and Runners-up will be held at the venue after each Division's Grand Final.



SECTION 4: COMMENCEMENT OF THE COMPETITION

Team nominations

- **Team Contacts** must nominate in their chosen competition through MyNetball and accessed on the NQ website – [Social Netball webpage](#).

- Teams must submit a “Team Name”. Those proposing a name that has already been taken, or that is deemed offensive will be asked to select an alternative.
- Teams will need to pay an online deposit at the time of nomination in order to submit their team.

Nomination Period

- The Team nomination period for the Monday Competition will:
 - Open **Monday 17th December 2018**.
 - Early Bird Nomination will close **Monday 14th January 2019**.
 - All further nominations will close **Monday 28th January 2019**.
- The Team nomination period for the Wednesday Competition will:
 - Open **Monday 17th December 2018**.
 - Early Bird Registration will close **Monday 14th January 2019**.
 - **All further nominations will close Wednesday 20th February 2019.**

- Teams who nominate and pay their deposit by the Early Bird closing date go in the draw to win 1 of 2 early bird prizes.
- The 2 winning teams (1 per competition) will have their remaining fees waived.
- Late nominations will only be accepted at the discretion of NQ.



Fees

- The total team fee for Season 1 2019 is \$1900* which covers a full season of grading, regular season rounds and finals games.
- This team registration fee also includes NQ insurance coverage for all players registered to that team. No additional player registration payment is required.
- Teams will be required to pay an initial (non-refundable) deposit of \$300 at time of nomination via MyNetball.
- Remaining team fee of \$1600 will be invoiced out to each team after their nomination.
- Teams must pay their invoiced fees **BEFORE** grading games commence.
 - Monday 4th February 2019 (Monday Competition) or
 - **Wednesday 27th February 2019 (Wednesday Competition)**
- Failure to pay the fee by this due date may result in competition penalties for the un-financial team/s. Penalties could include but are not limited to, suspension of competition points or suspension from taking the court until fees are paid, deduction of competition points and/or removal from the competition.
- There will be NO credits carried over to future Social Netball seasons.
- There will be NO refunded fees for BYEs and Win on Forfeit.

**Total team fees will be less for the Wednesday Competition: \$1680. This is due to a smaller competition and will be reflected on the invoice sent out after team nomination.*

Player Registrations

- **All players**, including Team Contacts, must conduct a 2019 Season 1 Player Registration to be registered to their team/s,
- If a player wishes to play in both the Monday and Wednesday Competition or in both a Women's and Mixed team, they must register separately as part of both teams.
- Teams can register as many players as they wish.
- Player registrations open **Tuesday 1st January 2018**.
- **All Players** must be registered by the end of the grading games, the **18th February 2019** (Monday Competition) and the **13th March 2019** (Wednesday Competition).
- Any players who are not registered by this closing date will not be covered by insurance and may incur penalties for their team if they take the court.
- Player Registrations are made through MyNetball and the NQ website – [Social Netball webpage](#).

- Team Contacts will be provided with further information about player registrations once team nominations have been made and deposit paid.
- Team Contacts must contact the Competition Coordinator about any new players who join the competition after the cut-off date. They will be required to show evidence of the new player's registration before they take the court.

Individual Players

- Individual players who do not have a team may contact the Competitions Coordinator to express their interest to play. They will then be listed on an Individual Player register. If teams contact the Coordinator requiring extra players the Team Contact will be provided with the Individual Player list (and contact details)
- Alternatively Individual Players can access the ['2019 Social Netball' Team App](#) and use the *'Monday Competition Individual and fill in Players'* or *'Wednesday Competition Individual and fill in Players'* to disclose their contact details to other players/teams and communicate in order to join a team.
- If teams require extra players before the commencement of the season or during the season it is their responsibility to contact these players to join their team.
- Once these Individual players have been contacted to join a team they must complete the player registration through MyNetball before the commencement of the season/their first game.
- During the season if teams require fill in players they can use the chat rooms on the Team App to do so.



SECTION 5: TEAM REQUIREMENTS

Team Uniform

- Uniforms will consist of a bodysuit or a shirt/singlet and skirt/ shorts/ bike pants/tights.
- Suitable indoor sports footwear is required (spiked soles are not allowed).
- All players **must** play in matching uniforms. This means that shirts must be identical in colour and shorts/skirts/tights must match in colour.
- Failure for a player to do so will result in that player being unable to take the court as per the Competition Coordinators discretion.
- If this therefore affects the minimum player requirements for the team then the Extreme Late Forfeit penalty will apply for that team.
- Players are permitted to wear skins or other compression/sportswear type pants.
- All teams should supply their own team bibs/positional patches.
- If by the umpires discretion teams must change their bibs (i.e. colour clash amongst the two teams playing) then the team will be able to borrow bibs from the Competitions Office for no further fee.
- If however teams need to borrow bibs without any appointment from the umpire, they will be required to pay a \$5 fee to the Competitions Coordinator on the night.
- No item of jewellery, except a medical alert bracelet, must be worn.
- If a medical adornment is worn, a medical certificate must be supplied to the Coordinator before any commencement of play.
- The medical adornment must be taped to prevent the risk of injury to the wearer or any other person on the court.
- The player can then continue to play however they do so at their own risk of injury and may not be covered by NQ insurance.
- Fingernails will be short and smooth to the umpires' satisfaction. Gloves are permitted.
- If glasses are worn they must be properly secured to the umpires' satisfaction.
- No game will be delayed beyond the scheduled commencement time to permit any uniform offence to be rectified. The offending player will not be allowed on the court until uniform requirements are satisfied. Late player rules apply.

Scorers

- Teams will be required to provide a scorer for their games.
- Only 1 scorer per game is required and this is alternated between teams throughout the season. The team providing the scorer will be the designated home team for that game as seen on the draw.
- If a scorer is not provided this will result in a player being removed from



- the court to undertake scoring duties.
- All scorers must be at least 15 years of age.
 - The score sheet will be deemed to be the official result.
 - Umpires, Captains of both teams, and the Scorer for the game will be required to sign the scoresheet at the competition of the game.
 - During the Finals series both teams are required to supply a scorer.

Team card

- The Team Card must be completed at the Competitions Office prior to the commencement of the game. All players of the team must complete their details and sign the team card.
- If a player fails to sign the team card their game will not be counted towards their number of games in the season, effecting their eligibility for finals.
- If a player fails to sign the team card during the 3 grading games and are NOT registered to a team they will NOT be covered by NQ insurance.



SECTION 6: OTHER COMPETITION RULES

Mixed Netball Position Rules

- A maximum of 3 males are permitted to be on the court at any time.
- A team may play with a minimum of one (1) male.
- The male players must play in the following areas;
 - 1 Goal Shooter or Goal Attack.
 - 1 Centre court player (WA, C, WD) AND
 - 1 Goal Defense or Goal Keeper.
- If only two (2) males are on the court then they must play in a Goal Defense or Goal Keeper AND a Goal Shooter or Goal Attack position. Therefore NO male player will be in a Centre court position.

Substitutions

- No player arriving after play has commenced can replace a player on court until an interval or injury.
- The player may enter the game, if a position is vacant, while play is in progress but only after a goal has been scored, or immediately following an interval, or during a stoppage for injury/illness.
- The player must firstly notify the umpires if she/he wishes to enter the game.

Injury Time

- There will be no time outs during grading and fixture round games. The timing will continue and games will conclude at the scheduled time.
- An injured player can take up to 30sec to leave the court. This player may be replaced once they have left the court.
- Injury time will be played during finals only.
- During a stoppage for injury or illness both teams will be allowed to make substitutions and/or team changes if desired.

Blood Policy

- Players sustaining bleeding injuries will move or be removed from the court as soon as possible.
- Any blood marks on the court, clothing/bib or the ball must be removed and disinfected immediately by the bleeding player or First Aid Officer at the venue.
- Players will not take the court with bleeding wounds or wounds that are not adequately covered.

First Aid

- A certified First Aid Officer will be supplied at the venue by NQ during all games.
- It is the responsibility of the NQ First Aid Officer to provide immediate assistance to the injured player with on court injuries or to continue treatment of injuries after player has been removed from the court.
- They are authorized to provide the appropriate medical advice/treatment including ice bags which will be made available.
- Only NQ officials are to call for an ambulance.
- Injury Report Forms will need to be completed on the night of which the injury occurred.

Personal Injury Claim

- Only players who are registered as a player for the Season 1 Competition are covered under the NQ insurance policy.
- The Personal Injury Claim Form is to be used by any registered player injured during competition.

- Players are required to complete all relevant sections of the paperwork.
- The declaration by association/club will require the Competition Coordinator's signature.
- Once all areas of the paperwork are completed player must return it to V-Insurance Group.

Complaints, Protests and Suspensions

Behaviour of players/spectators

- Netball Queensland requires all Players, Umpires and Parents/Spectators to comply with the General Code of Behaviour Policy (*as outlined in the [Netball Queensland Member Protection Policy - PART A – Codes of Behaviour](#)*) and to be read upon player registration.
- Team Contacts are responsible for the behaviour of all team players and spectators on and off the court.
- Inappropriate behavior, disrespect and foul language will not be tolerated.
- This behavior and any other behavior deemed to not be in the good spirit of the game will result in players being sent from the court at the discretion of the Umpire. Spectators will also be removed.



- Players who are sent off from the game will receive an automatic two-week suspension. Further disciplinary action may be applied at the discretion of the Competitions Coordinator.
- Players who are repeatedly reported for foul language or aggressive behavior will be removed from the competition at the Competitions Coordinator's discretion.

Submitting a protest/complaint

- A player or umpire may submit a complaint/protest report form to the Competitions Coordinator or NQ at any time.
- Any protest or complaint made relating to that specific game must be submitted within 48hrs after the completion of that game.
- NQ aim to provide a simple, confidential and trustworthy procedure for resolving complaints based on the principles of procedural fairness.
- The complaint will be reviewed initially and if deemed there is a need to investigate further, the complainant will be required to pay a fee of \$100. If the complaint is successfully appealed, the fee will be refunded.
- Complaint forms will be made available at the venue.
- A protest or complaint must include a team name, opposition team name, division, time, nature of protest or complaint, and the names of people involved.
