Directions

Lane Cove River Tourist Park is located in Lane Cove National Park on Plassey Road, North Ryde/Macquarie Park, NSW 2113.

You will not be able to reach the tourist park via Riverside Drive.

By car

If you're travelling by car, please load your GPS destination as Plassey Road, Macquarie Park. Alternatively, enter the following decimal degrees as your destination: -33.78952666, 151.14316666.

By public transport

There are many public transport options to get to Lane Cove River Tourist Park.

- North Ryde train station is a short 900m walk from the tourist park
- Turn right out of the train station on Delhi Road, and walk down a slight hill
- Turn left into Plassey Road
- The tourist park entrance is 700m on the right.

Vehicle access

2WD vehicles/ sealed roads/ all weather

Accessibility

Medium – assistance may be required to access this area. A disabled shower and toilet is located at amenities block number 3.

Check in and check out

Check in between 2pm and 6pm.
Check out by 10am.

Late check ins must be pre-arranged with the office on (02) 9888 9133 by 5pm and may not be accepted after 9pm.

Site numbers will be confirmed upon check in.

Keys/access

Guests must check in on arrival to confirm their site number and receive their PIN code to enter the park.

Parking

Each site has parking available for one vehicle. Additional vehicles must be parked outside the tourist park.

Park entrance fee

Park entry fees are not required to access Lane Cove River Tourist Park.

Fees apply when visiting other areas of Lane Cove National Park and can be purchased from pay-and-display machines.

Types of camping

All equipment must be kept within the campsite boundaries.

Camping is only permitted in designated campsites/areas.

Campsites are marked and suitable for motorhomes, caravans, camper trailers, campervans and tents.

Number of guests

The property must only be occupied by the number of customers and guests specified and paid for in the reservation confirmation.

Maximum number of guests
6 guests

Facilities

- There are powered and unpowered campsites in a variety of sizes, with grass, pad or concrete slabs bases.
- There are also *cabins* and a luxury style safari tent – *Tandara*, available to book in the tourist park
- The tourist park has a swimming pool and paddling pool
- There are 2 camp kitchens with

cooking facilities, instant hot water on tap, fridge (please label food), a microwave and toaster. Barbecues facilities are adjacent.

- There are four shared amenities blocks with laundry facilities including (coin-operated) washing machines and dryers, ironing boards and drying lines, hot showers and toilets.
- Irons are available from reception.
- Recreation room - this shared room includes a large screen TV and 2 computers with wireless internet
- There is a young children's play area
- Gas/electric barbecues (free), and picnic tables are available throughout the tourist park
- The tourist park has its own wireless internet network within a limited area

Facilities close by

There are nearby shops and facilities to pick up supplies, however not within walking distance (approx. 2.5km). Basic items are available at reception e.g. milk, bread, drinks, ice cream, chips etc.

Public transport, including buses, is available from North Ryde railway station, on Delhi Road. This is a 700-metre walk from reception.

Power

Lane Cove River Tourist Park is connected to mains power grid, with solar power available at designated locations.

There are powered and unpowered [campsites](#) available, all [cabins](#) and [Tandara](#) are powered.

Water

Drinking water is available at the tourist park.

Telephone/mobile service

There is mobile reception available throughout the tourist park.

A coin-operated public pay phone is available at the tourist park entrance on Plassey Road.

Fires

Fires are not permitted.

Total fire bans

During a total fire ban (minimum 24-hour period):

- All campfire and solid fuel (wood, heat beads, charcoal, briquettes, hexamite) and liquid fuel (petroleum, oil, methylated spirits, kerosene) barbecues and stoves are prohibited.
- All visitor-owned gas and electric barbecues and cookers are prohibited (total fire bans do not restrict the use of gas or electric cookers within a caravan or 3-sided enclosed annexe of a caravan)
- Gas/electric barbecues installed by NPWS are permitted

Rubbish

Rubbish bins are available, please use recycling bins when appropriate.

Cleaning

Please clean the barbecue facilities after use.

Noise

For the benefit of others, noise should be kept to a minimum.

There is a noise curfew in effect from 10pm–6am.

Pets

Smoking

Generators

Generators are not permitted.

Amplified music

Amplified music is not permitted.

Emptying of chemical toilets into amenities

Chemical toilets e.g. porta potties are permitted, but guests must use the dump facilities provided for waste disposal.

Wildlife

Do not feed wildlife. Ensure food and rubbish is properly stored to prevent access by wildlife.

Bookings

Bookings can be made up to 12 months in advance.

Length of stay

There is a maximum stay of 4 weeks (28 days) for all guests. After a stay of 4 weeks guests must vacate the park for a minimum of 2 weeks. There is a maximum stay of 12 weeks (84 days) in any 12 month period.

Pool

Children under the age of twelve (12) are not permitted to use the pool without a parent or guardian present.

Safety

It's great to explore and experience NSW national parks. Naturally, we encourage you to see and do as much as possible. We also want you and your companions to stay safe.
