The Alice Springs Steiner School (TASSS) is a thriving independent, co-educational school established 28 years ago on Arrernte Country. Our campus, nestled at the foot of the majestic Tjoritja (MacDonnell) Ranges and just 10 minutes from the township of Mparntwe / Alice Springs, provides an inspiring environment for learning.

We serve more than 200 students from Preschool to Class 9, with plans for continued growth. Our first purpose-built Middle School building opened in 2025, with Stage 2 scheduled for completion by June 2026.

"To be a world-class Steiner School in the heart of Australia."

TASSS is governed by the Alice Springs Steiner Association (TASSA) and supported by a dedicated Governing Body, College of Teachers, administrative team, and engaged parent community. Together, we uphold Steiner pedagogy and nurture the educational journey of children in Central Australia.

## **Expansive Grounds for Holistic Education**

Situated in the heart of Central Australia, our Steiner school is set on expansive grounds, thoughtfully designed to inspire learning and connection with nature. The campus features architecturally designed, reverse cycle air-conditioned classrooms, a well-equipped library, dedicated spaces for learning support, a nourishing Farm Garden, shaded basketball court, an oval and a hall for a range of community and school events.

These modern amenities provide an optimal environment for fostering the well-being and holistic development of every student.

- A designated Early Childhood space.
- Substantial new Middle School building, due to be completed in 2026 providing spacious learning spaces for classes 7 to 9.
- Beautifully resourced Library.
- Range of sporting facilities basketball court and playing field.

- Modern air-conditioned classrooms.
- Multi-purpose School Hall.
- Dedicated learning support spaces.
- A well resourced Community Kitchen.

- Lead recruitment, performance management, and professional development.
- Build a workplace culture grounded in collaboration and Steiner values.

- Actively engage with families and the wider Alice Springs community.

- Foster belonging and inclusivity across the school.

## **Essential Requirements**

- Bachelor of Education (postgraduate study in Educational Leadership or equivalent desirable).
- Registration or eligibility for registration with the NT Teacher Registration Board.
- Minimum five years' experience in a school leadership role, ideally in Steiner or values-based education.
- Demonstrated understanding of Steiner pedagogy and anthroposophy.
- Strong knowledge of governance, compliance, and financial management.

We seek a leader who is:

- Visionary, yet grounded and pragmatic.
- Warm, collaborative, and community-minded.
- Calm under pressure, with integrity and humility.
- Deeply respectful of children, families, and educators.
- Able to balance long-term vision with day-to-day operational demands.

## **Key Selection Criteria**

- 1. Educational Leadership and Vision Proven ability to lead a whole school community with a focus on quality teaching, continuous improvement, and holistic student development.
- 2. Steiner Educational Philosophy Commitment to and demonstrated understanding of Steiner pedagogy and anthroposophy.
- 3. Collaborative Leadership and Staff Development Experience in leading staff through a relational, respectful, and supportive approach.
- 4. Strategic and Operational Management Capacity to manage financial, operational, and compliance responsibilities in an independent school setting.
- 5. Community Engagement and Communication Excellent communication skills, with the ability to engage stakeholders and represent the school confidently.

- A one-page cover letter outlining interest in the role and availability.
- A detailed Curriculum Vitae including qualifications, experience, and three referees.
- A two-page response addressing the selection criteria.
