Are you passionate about helping children learn, grow, and thrive?

This is a nationally recognised qualification which prepares you to work as an early childhood educator in a range of settings. You'll learn how to support children's wellbeing, learning, and development while meeting the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard.

Requirements

- A **Laptop** with Microsoft Word.
- A current and valid employee **Northern Territory Working with Children Clearance** (Ochre Card).
- A **Traineeship placement** in an Early Learning Centre.
- **Uniform:** CENTVET polo shirt (learner to purchase). Neat, tidy clothing that meets workplace expectations (avoid short shorts, cycling shorts, and midriff tops). A sun hat. Shoes with back strap or enclosed shoes.

Delivery

Duration: Runs for one school year

Dates: 4 February start – every Wednesday

Time: 8.30am – 3:00pm during school terms

Mode: Face-to-face classes, theory assessments, practical activities, and possible excursions

Where you will learn: Training takes place at the VET Centre on the grounds of MacKillop Catholic College, as well as in your vocational workplace and other sites of interest.

First Aid training is delivered on 9 & 10 June by St John's; organised by CENTVET RTO.

Workplace Learning: You will work as a trainee in an early learning centre for at least one day per week throughout the course (48 days work in total). There are also compulsory vocational block weeks at the end of each term which may be volunteered or rostered.

Assessments: All learning materials, and assessments are provided. To be completed in electronic format.

Fees: No course cost for learners in school. Adults contact office for fees.

Check with the office for any additional delivery locations of this qualification.
