

COURSE OUTLINE

Electrical Contractors Licence – Qualified Technical Person (QTP) course

This course has been designed for Queensland Licensed Electricians to gain the qualification requirements to become a Qualified Technical Person on a Queensland Electrical Contractors Licence. Upon successful completion of the course students will be awarded the following nationally recognized units of competency:

UEEEL0002 Apply currency of safe working practices and compliance verification of electrical installations

UEEEL0030 Conduct compliance inspection of single-phase LV electrical installations

UEEEL0029 Conduct compliance inspection of LV electrical installations with demand exceeding 100 A per phase

ENROLMENT:

Knowledge assessment: We will ask you to provide evidence of your electrical qualifications, licence and work experience. This is to determine whether you hold the required pre-requisite knowledge prior to completing the QTP course. We may also ask you to complete a 3 question test to determine how best we can support your learning.

TRAINING & ASSESSMENT:

Face-to-face classroom delivery – Over 4 days in the classroom you will complete the theory and practical learning and assessment. The course will include cable selection, voltage drop and maximum demand calculations and will focus heavily on mandatory test procedures. Please note, you must have your own copies of AS/NZS 3000 and AS/NZS 3008 to complete this course.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO DO THIS COURSE:

Electricians who hold the required pre-requisite qualification and knowledge. Those that hold a UEE30811 Certificate III in Electrotechnology – Electrician will only need to supply evidence of this qualification and a valid electrical licence to complete the course. If you hold any other Electrical Qualification then you will need to provide both evidence of your qualification and your work experience.

COURSE DURATION:

4 days face-to-face in the classroom.

COURSE OUTCOMES:

Participants will gain skills that enable them to fulfil the role of Qualified Technical Person on a Queensland Electrical Contractors licence.

ASSESSMENT: THEORY & PRACTICAL
