

Terms & Conditions

FBAA Awards of Supremacy 2026

1. The Finance Brokers Association of Australasia Limited (FBAA) Awards of Supremacy are open to all members of the FBAA and/or their Industry BDMS.
2. Each entry must be made in accordance with these terms and conditions. By entering the FBAA Awards of Supremacy, each nominee and each person submitting a nomination agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.
3. Entries must be complete in every respect and received by the FBAA by **5:00pm AEST, Friday 29 May 2026**. Late entries will not be accepted.
4. Entries may only be submitted via the official submissions portal. Entries submitted in any other manner will not be accepted.
5. Selection criteria may include (but are not limited to) disclosure of the gross amount of loans brokered by the nominee for the calendar year of 2025. Supporting documentation from lenders or aggregators must be attached to the nomination to allow the judging panel to verify the stated amount. It is the responsibility of the nominee or nominator to obtain any necessary consents for sharing this information. If this documentation is not provided, the judging panel reserves the right to reject the entry.
6. The judging panel shall consist of no fewer than two and no more than five individuals, appointed by the FBAA. Their names may be disclosed to members prior to or during the Awards of Supremacy.
7. The judging panel will determine winners from entries deemed acceptable. Judging criteria will:
 - Include all information required on the entry form;
 - Align with the objectives of the FBAA, as outlined in its Constitution and Code of Conduct;
 - Remain otherwise at the discretion of the judging panel, with consideration for the interests and reputation of the FBAA and its members.
8. All decisions of the judging panel are final and binding. No correspondence will be entered into regarding any outcome.
