The vessel Pacific Tiger has been configured uniquely for bed levelling and has been successfully completing campaigns on the east and southern coastlines of Australia since 2007. The vessel is a tried and trusted machine with an impressive track record, consistently delivering projects on schedule.

HYRDROGRAPHIC SURVEY

Our lead vessel, the Sounds Pacific has been completing Queensland wide port surveys and the annual Weipa dredging campaign since her purchase and refit in 2022.

- Fitted with 750mm x 600mm moon pool to accommodate hydrographic survey equipment

WRECK REMOVAL & SALVAGE

FMG has a specialised & committed team working with local government agencies and international insurance companies for the fast and effective recovery of stricken and sunken vessels.

- We often work under the "No Cure, No Pay" contracts for our international clients
- Purpose-built salvage equipment including heavy lift air bags and heavy-duty A-Frames mounted to salvage barge
- Removal of seabed debris, ships anchors and marine hazards
- · Fast deployment of assets and crew.







RESEARCH & ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING

Our team has a long history of involvement with a number of research operations throughout Queensland waters. FMG is entering a new vessel in this space with the 35m catamaran, Shepparton. She will be equipped with large client-only meeting rooms and relaxation spaces and feature an airconditioned wet lab with direct access to the aft deck and a 10 tonne, 5-metre-wide A frame. FMG has dedicated industry partners within the Commercial dive support 8 supply space to assist with our projects.


