Laptop Lease Package

Holy Spirit College is implementing a Laptop Lease Package for all Year 7 students in 2024. Year 7 students will receive a College issued laptop, charger and bag at the beginning of the 2024 school year.

Year 7 students will lease their laptop from the College for their use throughout Years 7, 8 and 9. From Year 10, students will receive a new laptop, charger and bag for their Senior schooling.

The cost of the College-owned laptop, charger and bag is included in your annualised school fees. This laptop is intended for school use only.

Cyber-Safety Culture

The overall goal of the College is to create and maintain a cybersafety culture. Holy Spirit College filters internet access whilst students are at the College and at home.

The use of Information and Communications Technologies (ICT) within the College should be safe, responsible, legal, appropriate and for educational purposes.

Students and parents/carers will be required to accept Terms & Conditions in our *ICT Code of Practice*.

This package is designed to assist parents and students to obtain a laptop device compatible with the Holy Spirit College network at a competitive cost.
