APPROVAL CURRENCY PERIOD

Pursuant to Section 85 of the *Planning Act 2016*, the development approval will lapse four years after the approval starts to have effect, unless otherwise conditioned.

APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

The development must be carried out in accordance with the approved plans, specifications and/or drawings, along with the requirements of all relevant laws. Any deviation must have prior approval from the Chief Executive Officer.

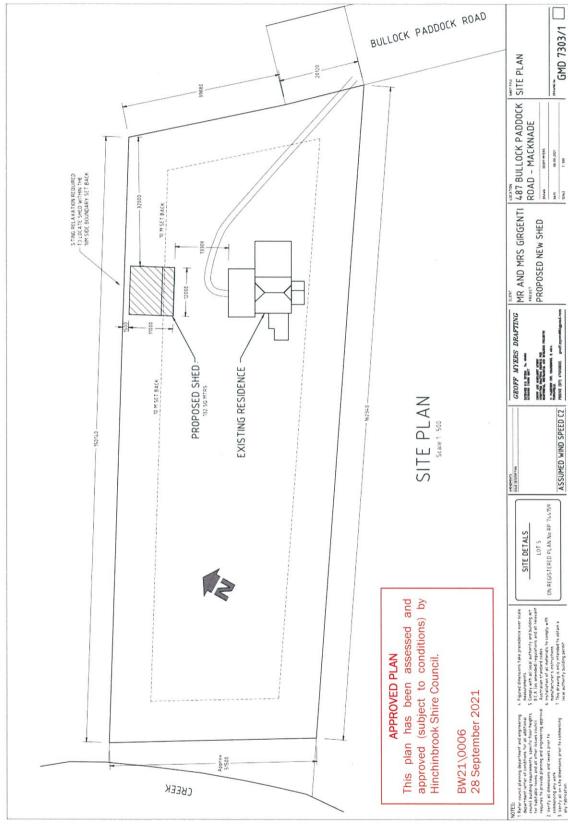

	4.3 The Class 10a structure requires compliance to relevant Fire Safety regulations as reflected in s3.7.1.6 of the <i>Building Code of Australia</i> (Volume Two), as required.	
5.	Construction and Operation Any construction work associated with this development shall be carried out in accordance with sound engineering practice. In particular, no nuisance is to be caused to adjoining residents by way of smoke, dust, stormwater discharge or siltation of drains, at any time, including nonworking hours. Where material is to be carted to or from the site, loads are to be covered to prevent dust or spillage. Where material is spilled or carried onto existing roads, it is to be removed forthwith so as to restrict dust nuisance and ensure traffic safety. Any construction works associated with the access arrangements to the property from the road reserve is subject to a Private Works in a Road Reserve application and approval. 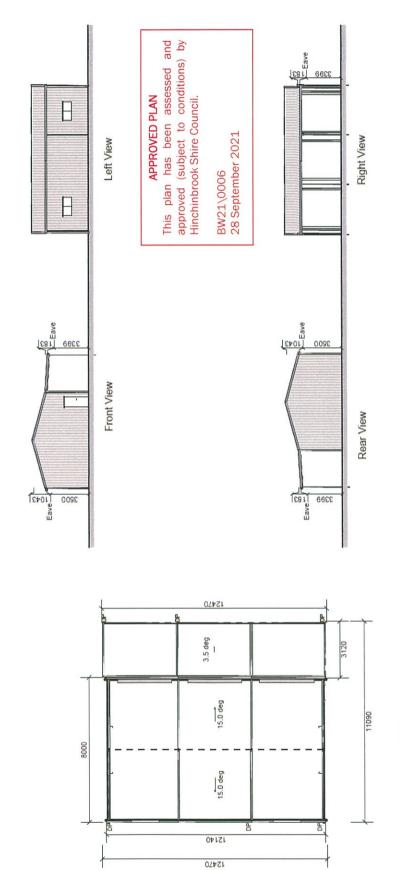
ASSUMED WIND SPEED C2
