Ingham Dirt Bike Club Events and NAIDOC Week

2019-2020 Budget Allocates Funds to Upgrade Parks, Playgrounds and Foreshore Areas.

Council has been successful in obtaining \$2,400,000 from the State Government under its Works for Queensland program to be actioned from July 2019 to June 2021.

Council plans to utilise this funding on foreshore improvements at Forrest Beach, Taylors Beach and Lucinda whilst also assessing the needs at Rotary Park, the Halifax township and the Trebonne township.

The intent here is to enhance the liveability of our district for locals and to facilitate an aesthetically pleasing environment as part of our destination marketing activities.

Council will be seeking ideas from the community and relevant stakeholders prior to finalising any design plans.
