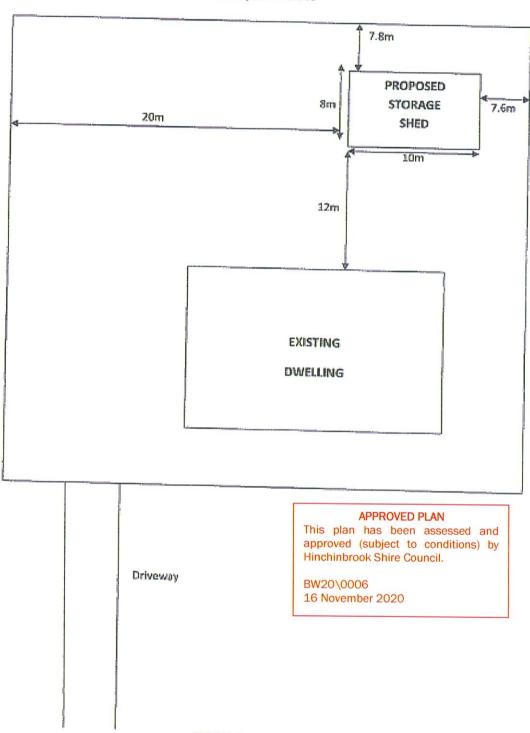

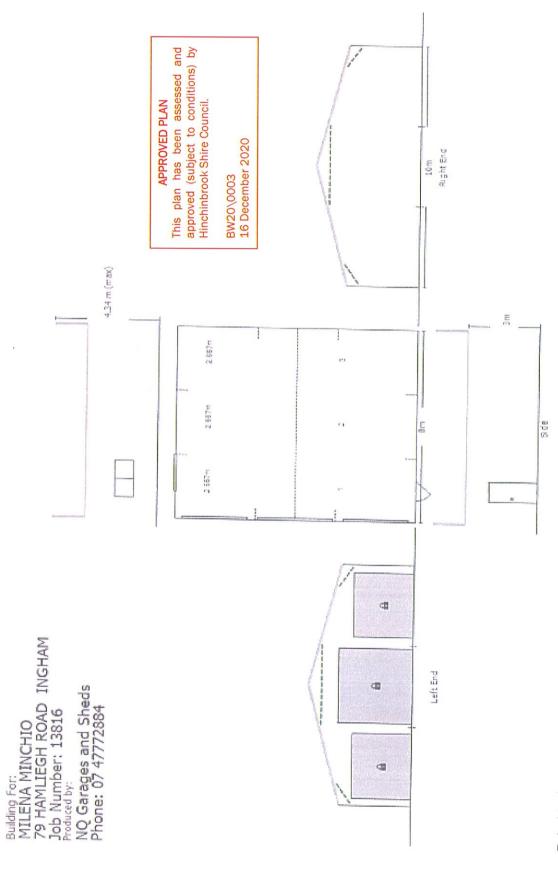
SITE PLAN: Milena Minchio 79 Hamleigh Road, Ingham 4850 Lot 5, RP838249
