TOTAL INVESTMENT \$22.1 MILLION

WE ARE DELIVERING MAJOR UPGRADES TO IMPROVE SAFETY, RESILIENCE AND ACCESS ALONG MOUNT FOX ROAD AND WALLAMAN FALLS ROAD. THESE WORKS WILL STRENGTHEN A VITAL AGRICULTURAL CORRIDOR AND ENSURE RELIABLE ACCESS TO WALLAMAN FALLS, AUSTRALIA'S TALLEST SINGLE-DROP WATERFALL.

INVESTMENT BREAKDOWN

◆ \$18.6 MILLION LANDSLIP REMEDIATION

Funding will support remediation and slope stabilisation at:

- 35 landslip sites on Mount Fox Road
- 30 landslip sites on Wallaman Falls Road

◆ \$3.5 MILLION MOUNT FOX UPGRADE

An additional \$3.5 million will upgrade 16 priority locations along the Mount Fox Road corridor, improving safety and resilience for local residents, agricultural transport, tourism access, Defence movements, and the increased traffic associated with emerging energy precincts.

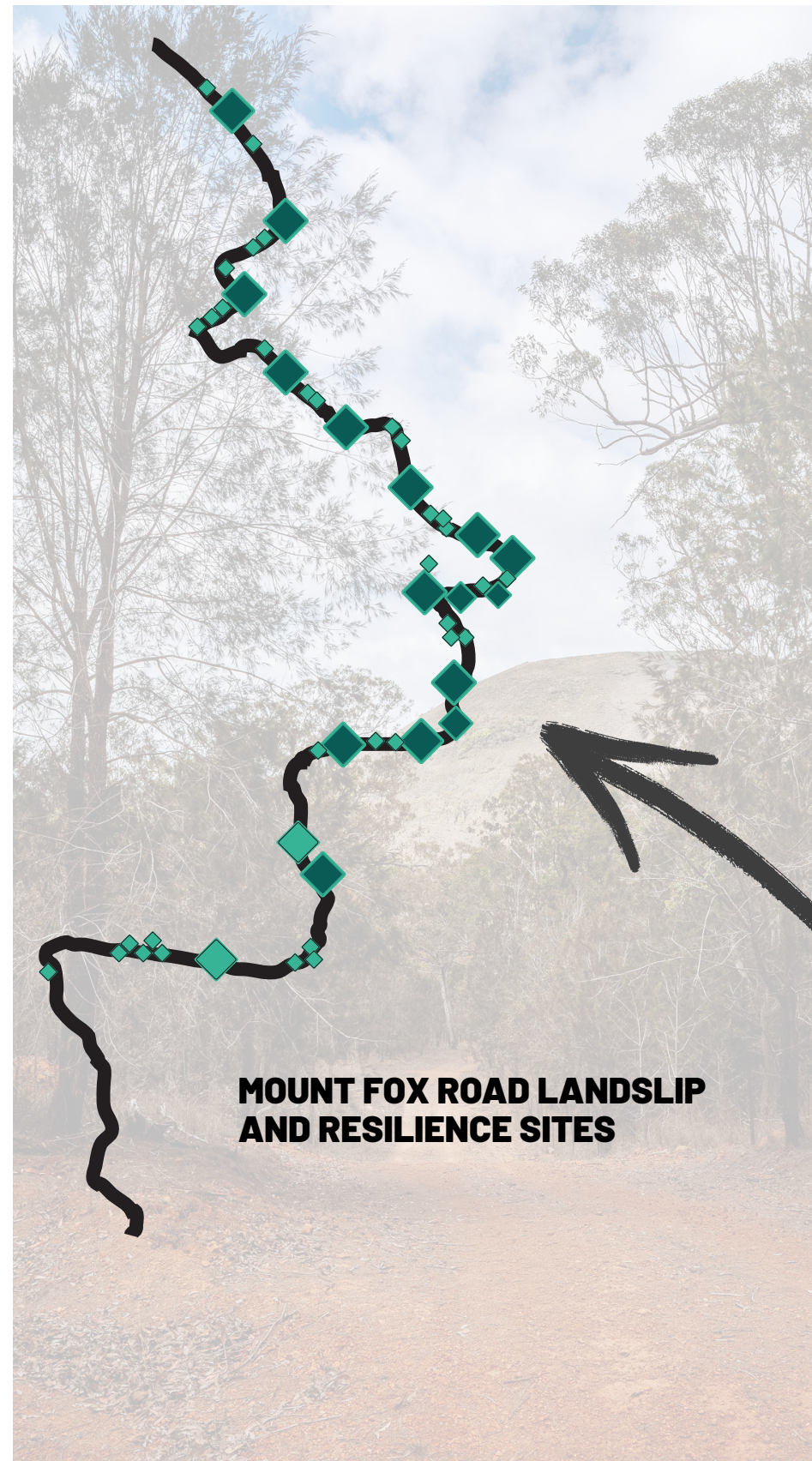
PROJECT TIMELINES

CONSTRUCTION START: Expected from April 2026 (subject to site conditions)

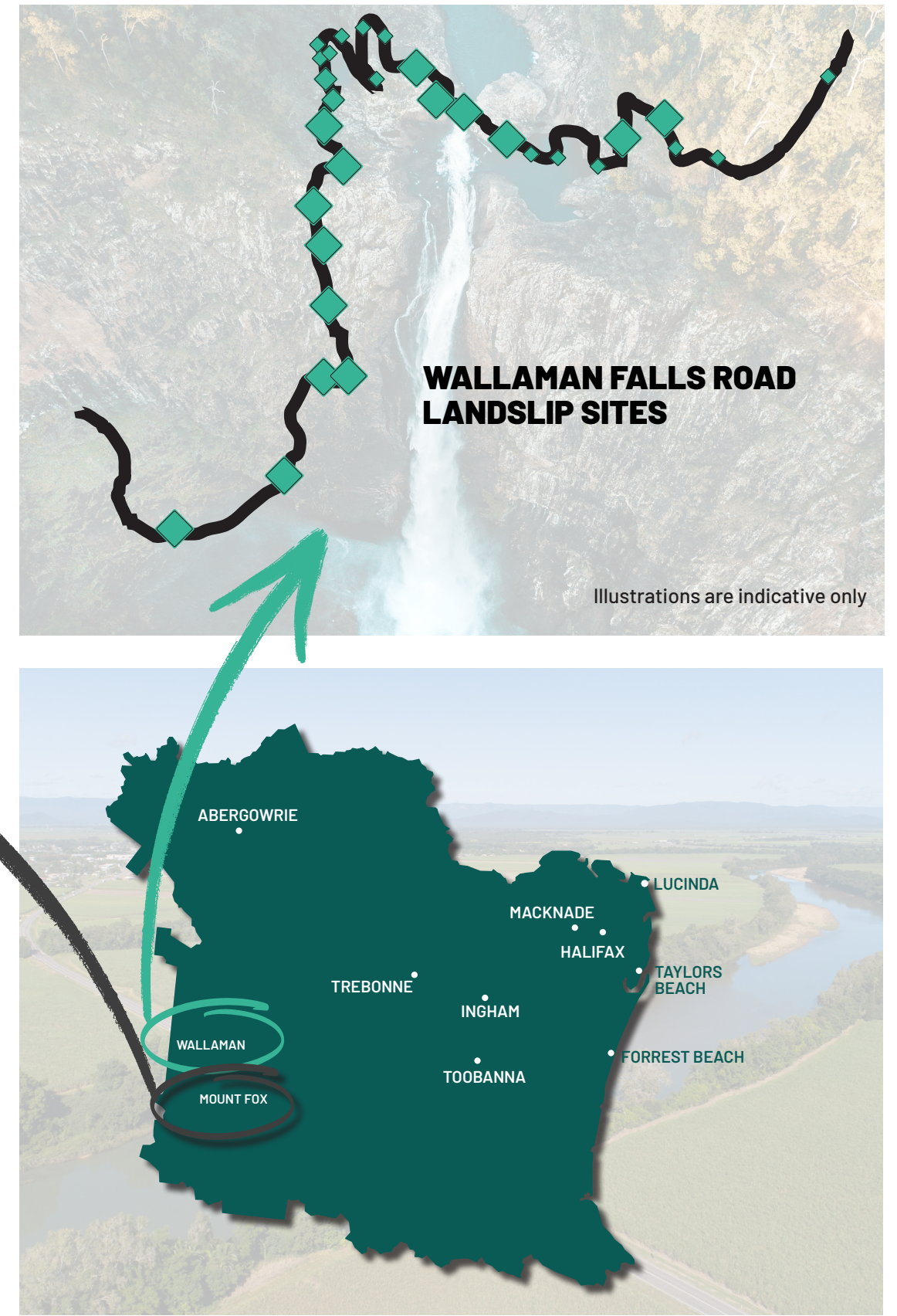
COMPLETION: Anticipated late 2027, weather permitting

TRAFFIC UPDATES: Contractors are expected to provide Council updates ahead of construction and throughout delivery to inform community.

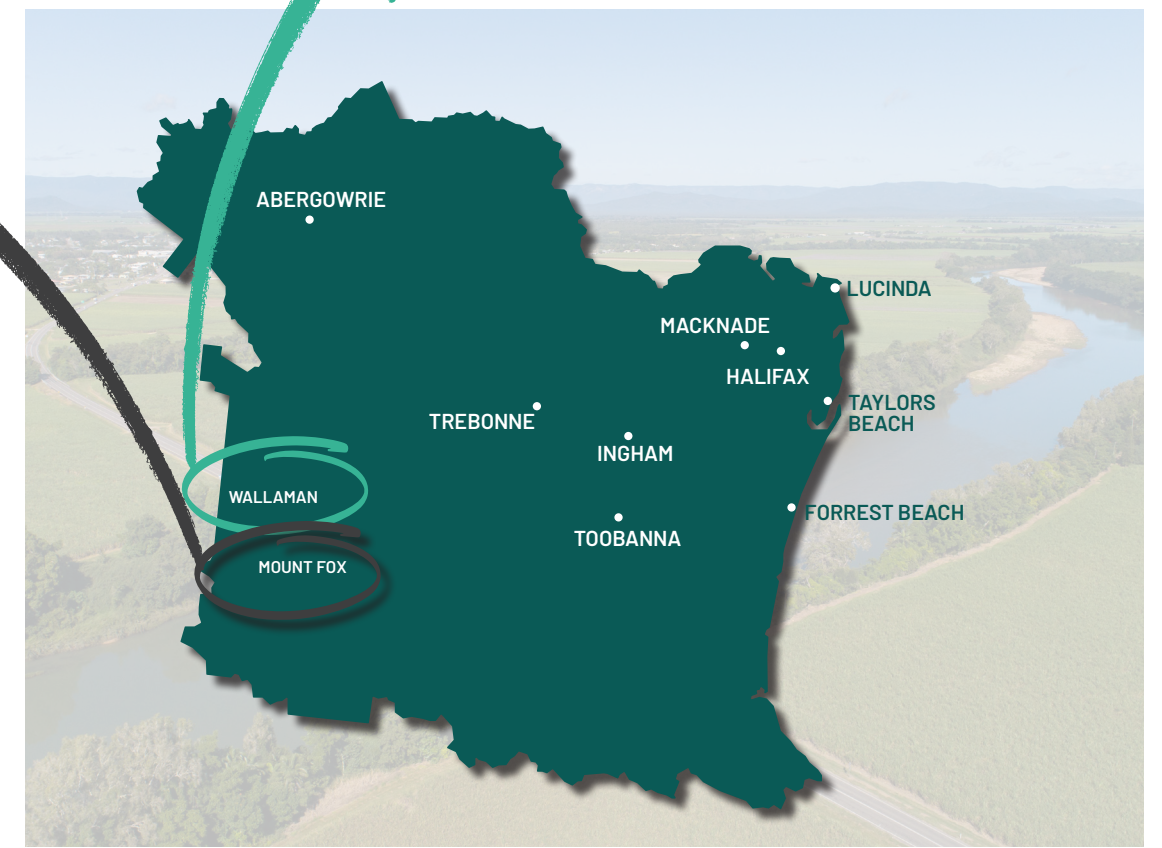


MOUNT FOX ROAD LANDSLIP
