



# North Queensland Restocking, Replanting & On-farm Infrastructure Grants

North & Far North Queensland Monsoon Trough, 25 January-14 February 2019

Rebuild your farm business in your own time and in your own way with a Restocking, Replanting and On-farm Infrastructure Grant. These Australian Government grants are supporting primary producers in North and Far North Queensland to get back to business.

Up to \$400,000 is available, with matched co-contributions.

## Eligible activities

These grants can assist with the cost of:

- restocking lost livestock.
- replanting lost or damaged crops or permanent plantings.
- restoring or replacing lost or damaged on-farm infrastructure.

## Eligibility requirements include

To be eligible, you must:

- be approved assistance under the Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grant scheme from QRIDA and have utilised the full \$75,000.
- be able to demonstrate the availability of funds to match grant funds requested.
- demonstrate the financial viability of your primary production enterprise after receipt of this grant.
- visit our website for a full list of eligibility requirements.

## Are you eligible?

To discuss your eligibility for a grant under this scheme, please call QRIDA on **Freecall 1800 623 946**. Follow the steps below to see if you could be eligible.

### Step 1

Have you been approved a **Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grant** from QRIDA?

You need to make use of the full \$75,000 before accessing a Restocking, Replanting and On-farm Infrastructure Grant.

### Step 2

Do you have access to a matched co-contribution?

#### Options for co-contribution funding include:

- available cash funds, or
- approved finance from commercial sources (e.g. your existing bank has agreed to provide additional funding), or
- approved loan from the Regional Investment Corporation, or
- approved disaster assistance loan from QRIDA.

### Step 3

Apply now for up to \$400,000 co-contribution grant funding to restock, replant, or repair on-farm infrastructure.
