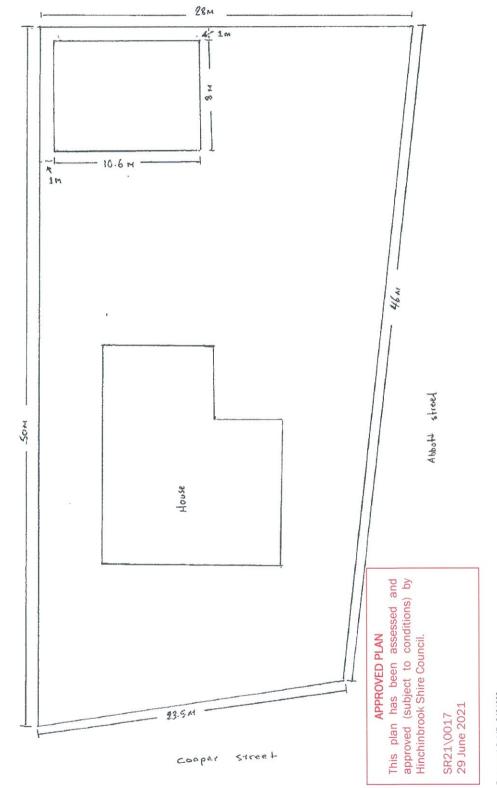

6.	Construction and Operation Any construction work associated with this development shall be carried out in accordance with sound engineering practice.
