* Road to be closed for the Dawn Parade at 4.15am ,reopened and then closed again for the Main Parade at 9am , then reopened to full traffic once the Parade is over and the road is clear.

APPLICATION :

- * Short Term Road Closure
- * Site specific for HSCs Anzac Day Parade.

NOTES:

- * The distance (D) is as per table 4.2 in the MUTCD (D) = 15 - 45m
- * The Road Closed Ahead (TC1803), Event in progress(TC1956) signs on Palm Terrace should be located 2 (D) from the intersection of Herbert SUPalm Terrace.
- * The Road Closed Ahead (TC1803), Event in Progress (TC1956) signs in Jane St near the Church should be located 2 (D) from the Jane/ Mcilwraith St intersection.
- * The Road Closed Ahead (TC1803), No Left or Right Turn (TC1818 L or R), Event in Progress (TC1956) signs on Mcilwraith St. should be 2 (D) from the Mcilwraith/Jane St. intersection.
- * At the end of Palm Terrace in line with the boundary of the Norqueb and the Vets properties , the Barrier Board (TC9215) and the Road Closed (T2-4) should be erected on the LHS with 3 Bollards blocking the rest of the Road to be adjusted to allow the Marchers and the official vehicle passage down the middle of the Road and then blocked off again once the marchers have gone through.
- * At the intersection of Jane/Mcilwraith the Barrier Boards(TC9215) and the Road Closed (T2-4) to be positioned to close both Lanes.
- * Two Bollards will be placed blocking the RH Turning lane into Jane St. from Mcilwraith St heading west.
- * All signs to be erected from the outside in and taken down in reverse.
- * The on call Sign installer to be on site during both Parades , to adjust the Palm Terrace/Jane St Bollards as needed, monitor the signs and also to open the road once it is safe to do so.
