



JCU 2021 UniSport Nationals – Queensland

INFORMATION SHEET

UPDATE ON THE EVENT: Due to the ongoing COVID-19 situation in NSW as well as the boarder restrictions across Australia, UniSport Australia have postponed. However, UniSport Australia in collaboration with the Queensland Universities will instead host a state competition.

WHEN: Sunday September 26 – Thursday September 30.

WHERE: Gold Coast, QLD

SPORTS INVOLVED:

We are looking to take the following teams down to the event.

- Basketball (Women's and Men's)
- Beach Volleyball (Women's Pairs, Men's Pairs and Mixed)
- Futsal (Men's)
- Netball (Women's and Mixed)
- Rugby 7s (Men's only)
- Touch Football (Mixed)

Please note that some sports that were originally planned to go ahead will no longer be happening. This includes women's rugby 7s. This is based on the lack of interest from other Queensland universities.

We are currently looking for players for the following sports:

- Basketball (Women's and Men's)
- Beach Volleyball (Men's Pairs and Mixed Fours)
- Rugby 7s (Men's)

Note all other sports have been finalised and will not require any other players.

TRAININGS AND TRIALS:

Trainings will be required for sports in the lead up to the event.

Depending on the interest, we may be required to do trials.

We will begin to confirm these days, times and venues in the near future.

We are looking to find venues across both the Townsville and Cairns Campuses to help train for the event.



COST:

These costs are applied for the Competition.

- Approx. \$125 Registration Fee to UniSport Australia. Paid online. Once you select your sport type JCU in the team code box and select the team. We will provide you with this in the future. Early Bird Registrations close on September 10 for the Competition, registrations after that date will incur an additional \$50.
- \$100 to JCUSA Sport & Recreation which covers four nights of accommodation on the Gold Coast, team polo, playing uniform and the flight down to the event (via Brisbane).
 - Everyone will be flying down on the same flight that will be organised through JCUSA Sport (in partnership with All Sports Travel). For the Townsville Students, we will be going on a Qantas Flight scheduled to depart at 9:05am on Sunday September 26.
- Flights to return to Cairns or Townsville – sourced individually. **STUDENTS ARE NOT TO DRIVE BACK TO TOWNSVILLE OR CAIRNS!!!**

ACCOMMODATION

We are staying at Tiki Hotel Surfers Paradise. This is the same venue we stayed at in 2019.

Tiki Hotel Surfers Paradise is just a 5 minute walk to the centre of Cavill Avenue and an 8 minute walk from the beach. All apartments have microwave facilities. The apartments don't have laundry facilities however the hotel does have \$1 coin operated machines and dryers.

Accommodation will be booked from Sunday September 26 with checkout on Thursday September 30.
