

INTRODUCTION

In November 2020, JCUSA Sport created a survey for JCU Students to complete. This survey was asking student's feedback on variety of areas including our facilities, programs and clubs across both our Townsville and Cairns Campuses. 224 students completed the survey throughout the month of November.

This data allows JCUSA Sport to get a better understanding from students what they would like to see with Sport and Recreation at JCU as well as where the department could improve.

The idea is to start implementing some of the feedback from 2021 while information from this survey will also help gain the support within the university as well as external stakeholders outside of JCU.

KEY FINDINGS

- JCU Students are more likely to hear about Sport and Recreation at JCU through O
 Week (45.54%), from fellow students (44.20%) and from living on campus (40.63%).
- Students are more likely to communicate and obtain news through Facebook (87.95%).
- The JCUSA Fitness Centre and the Joe Baker Field are the most used and important sporting facilities in Townsville meanwhile the JCU Gym is most important facility on the Cairns Campus.
- The top priority additions/improvements for sporting facilities in Townsville are improved pool facilities (30.43%) and an indoor facility (27.33%).
- The top priority additions/improvements for the Cairns Campus is an indoor facility (36.51%) and improved gym facilities (33.33%).
- 96.83% will or are likely to use the new JCU Cairns Gym once opened including 100.00% of respondents who used the previous facility.
- Students are more likely to sign up to Social Sport on both campuses for physical activity (78.48% in Townsville, 87.34% in Cairns), and/or continual engagement with friends (70.89% in Townsville, 75.00% in Cairns).
- A large percentage of students who did not play social sport this semester was due to clashes with their university schedule.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Fisher Shield (100.00%), Interfaculty Sport (88.89%) and Gunyarra Cup (83.33%) has allowed them to meet new people/friends.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Fisher Shield (98.36%) and Gunyarra Cup (72.22%) enhances the experience of living on campus.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Interfaculty Sport (86.11%) enhances their university experience.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Fisher Shield (98.36%), Interfaculty Sport (86.11%) and Gunyarra Cup (77.78%) are important programs to JCUSA Sport.



KEY FINDINGS

- With COVID-19 cancelling certain programs and events within Fisher Shield (84.21%), Interfaculty Sport (57.78%) and Gunyarra Cup (64.29%) students felt this impacted their overall experience in those programs.
- 91.00% of respondents are currently not involved with an affiliated JCU Sporting Club. Of those respondents, 77.67% are currently not involved with a sporting club outside of JCU.
- Students who are involved in a sporting club outside of JCU, 70.00% stated they are not part of an affiliated club at JCU because a club for their sport does not exist at JCU/on campus.
- 72.50% of respondents who are not involved with a JCU sporting club state they are more likely to join a JCU Sporting Club if a club existed on campus. This number increases to 81.88% when you remove responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- 78.00% of respondents who are not involved with a JCU Sporting Club said they are more likely to join a JCU Sporting Club if a facility existed on campus. This number increases to 86.96% when you remove responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- 100.00% of students who are involved in affiliated JCU Sporting Clubs agree or strongly agree that being part of a JCU Sporting Club has allowed them to meet new people/friends, creating university spirit and culture as well as enhancing their university experience.
- 97.32% of respondents have not competed at UniSport Nationals with 48.62% of those respondents indicating that they were not aware that the event existed while 29.82% have no interest in competing at a serious competition.
- 71.43% of respondents would participate in events on campus where they could represent JCU in their chosen sport. This number increases to 85.55% when you remove responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- 72.77% of respondents would participate for JCU if other universities came to Townsville or Cairns to compete against the university. This number increases to 87.74% when you remove the responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- 82.14% of respondents (94.97% when removing the responses from students who have no interest in serious competition) would be interested in competing in different towns across North Queensland.
- 86.61% of respondents (95.60% when removing the responses from students who have no interest in serious competition) would be interested in participating in a Townsville v Cairns intercampus competition.
- Monday's is the most popular day in Townsville to play sport on campus while Wednesday's and Friday's are the most popular days to play sport in Cairns.
- Students prefer to play sport on campus at night.



Finding out about Sport & Recreation at JCU

From the survey, it has been identified that JCU Students hear about the existence of JCUSA Townsville Sport through a variety of channels however the most popular being from O Week (45.54%), The JCUSA Fitness Centre (49.69%) and the Joe Baker Field (49.07%) are the most used from fellow JCU students (44.20%) as well as from living on college (40.63%). Meanwhile in Cairns students hear about JCUSA Sport on campus from fellow stu- Just over 39% of students did not use the pool prior to the COVID-19 shutdown with the most common reasons either being an unreliable facility (22.45%) as well as students not having any interest in using pools (35.71%). Only 46.58% of students would use the facility under it's current conditions. Improved pool facilities (30.43%) and an indoor facility (27.33%) were seen as the top priorities for the Townsville Campus. There was also a strong importance amongst students for more drinking stations for water as well as more spectator seating and shade.

Cairns

All sporting facilities across the campus get used evenly with the JCU Oval being the most used sporting facility (52.38%) however the JCU Gym is deemed as the most important sporting facility in Cairns. This statement is reinforced as 96.83% of respondents will or may likely be using the facility when opened including 100% of respondents who selected that they have used the JCU Gym before. While evenly spread across all days of the week, Friday's is deemed to be the most popular day for students to use the new gym (74.60%) close-Precinct E (69.84%) is the area that students will most likely to attend while on campus. 





Which Facilities do you use at JCU in Townsville?





Before the COVID-19 Shutdown, did you use the JCUSA Pool?









If the current pool was replaced with a new facility, would you use it?






Which improvement/addition is your top priority?

Are you involved in or have been previously involved in Social Sport?





Why did you previously sign up to play Social Sport?



Did you sign up to play Social Sport this semester?










If JCUSA Sport were to add a sport or replace a current sport, which sport would you prefer?





Do you prefer to play sport at JCU during the day or at night?








If JCUSA Sport were to hold Social Sport during the day, would you register/participate?







If there was a JCU sporting club located on campus tailored to your sport, are you more likely to join that club?





If we have a facility based on campus for your sport, are you more likely to join the JCU Sporting Club?





If there were more events held on campus where you can represent JCU in your chosen sport, would you participate/compete?










