

## INTRODUCTION

In November 2020, JCUSA Sport created a survey for JCU Students to complete. This survey was asking student's feedback on variety of areas including our facilities, programs and clubs across both our Townsville and Cairns Campuses. 224 students completed the survey throughout the month of November.

This data allows JCUSA Sport to get a better understanding from students what they would like to see with Sport and Recreation at JCU as well as where the department could improve.

The idea is to start implementing some of the feedback from 2021 while information from this survey will also help gain the support within the university as well as external stakeholders outside of JCU.

## KEY FINDINGS

- JCU Students are more likely to hear about Sport and Recreation at JCU through O Week (45.54\%), from fellow students (44.20\%) and from living on campus (40.63\%).
- Students are more likely to communicate and obtain news through Facebook (87.95\%).
- The JCUSA Fitness Centre and the Joe Baker Field are the most used and important sporting facilities in Townsville meanwhile the JCU Gym is most important facility on the Cairns Campus.
- The top priority additions/improvements for sporting facilities in Townsville are improved pool facilities (30.43\%) and an indoor facility (27.33\%).
- The top priority additions/improvements for the Cairns Campus is an indoor facility ( $36.51 \%$ ) and improved gym facilities ( $33.33 \%$ ).
- $\quad 96.83 \%$ will or are likely to use the new JCU Cairns Gym once opened including $100.00 \%$ of respondents who used the previous facility.
- Students are more likely to sign up to Social Sport on both campuses for physical activity ( $78.48 \%$ in Townsville, $87.34 \%$ in Cairns), and/or continual engagement with friends ( $70.89 \%$ in Townsville, $75.00 \%$ in Cairns).
- A large percentage of students who did not play social sport this semester was due to clashes with their university schedule.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Fisher Shield (100.00\%), Interfaculty Sport ( $88.89 \%$ ) and Gunyarra Cup ( $83.33 \%$ ) has allowed them to meet new people/friends.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Fisher Shield (98.36\%) and Gunyarra Cup ( $72.22 \%$ ) enhances the experience of living on campus.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Interfaculty Sport (86.11\%) enhances their university experience.
- Students agree or strongly agree that Fisher Shield (98.36\%), Interfaculty Sport ( $86.11 \%$ ) and Gunyarra Cup ( $77.78 \%$ ) are important programs to JCUSA Sport.


## KEY FINDINGS

- With COVID-19 cancelling certain programs and events within Fisher Shield (84.21\%), Interfaculty Sport (57.78\%) and Gunyarra Cup (64.29\%) students felt this impacted their overall experience in those programs.
- $\quad 91.00 \%$ of respondents are currently not involved with an affiliated JCU Sporting Club. Of those respondents, $77.67 \%$ are currently not involved with a sporting club outside of JCU.
- Students who are involved in a sporting club outside of JCU, $70.00 \%$ stated they are not part of an affiliated club at JCU because a club for their sport does not exist at JCU/on campus.
- $\quad 72.50 \%$ of respondents who are not involved with a JCU sporting club state they are more likely to join a JCU Sporting Club if a club existed on campus. This number increases to $81.88 \%$ when you remove responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- $\quad 78.00 \%$ of respondents who are not involved with a JCU Sporting Club said they are more likely to join a JCU Sporting Club if a facility existed on campus. This number increases to 86.96\% when you remove responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- $100.00 \%$ of students who are involved in affiliated JCU Sporting Clubs agree or strongly agree that being part of a JCU Sporting Club has allowed them to meet new people/friends, creating university spirit and culture as well as enhancing their university experience.
- $\quad 97.32 \%$ of respondents have not competed at UniSport Nationals with $48.62 \%$ of those respondents indicating that they were not aware that the event existed while $29.82 \%$ have no interest in competing at a serious competition.
- $\quad 71.43 \%$ of respondents would participate in events on campus where they could represent JCU in their chosen sport. This number increases to $85.55 \%$ when you remove responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- $\quad 72.77 \%$ of respondents would participate for JCU if other universities came to Townsville or Cairns to compete against the university. This number increases to $87.74 \%$ when you remove the responses from students who have no interest in serious competition.
- $\quad 82.14 \%$ of respondents ( $94.97 \%$ when removing the responses from students who have no interest in serious competition) would be interested in competing in different towns across North Queensland.
- $\quad 86.61 \%$ of respondents ( $95.60 \%$ when removing the responses from students who have no interest in serious competition) would be interested in participating in a Townsville v Cairns intercampus competition.
- Monday's is the most popular day in Townsville to play sport on campus while Wednesday's and Friday's are the most popular days to play sport in Cairns.
- Students prefer to play sport on campus at night.

## Facilities

From the survey, it has been identified that JCU Students hear about the existence of JCUSA Townsville
Sport through a variety of channels however the most popular being from O Week ( $45.54 \%$ ), The JCUSA Fitness Centre ( $49.69 \%$ ) and the Joe Baker Field ( $49.07 \%$ ) are the most used from fellow JCU students $(44.20 \%$ ) as well as from living on college ( $40.63 \%$ ). In Townsville, sporting facilities as well as being the most important facilities in Townsville (with a mean students hear about JCUSA Sport from O Week (48.45\%) as well as from living on college average rating of 3.86 and 3.75 respectively).

## Social Media Platforms

## Locations on Campus

Townsville
The most common places on campus where students will attend include University Central ( $47.83 \%$ ), Health Sciences ( $46.58 \%$ ) and Science and Engineering ( $40.37 \%$ ).

## Cairns

Precinct $\mathrm{E}(69.84 \%)$ is the area that students will most likely to attend while on campus. This is followed by Precinct B (46.03\%) and Precinct A (41.27\%).
You can find this data from Page 37. most common reasons either being an unreliable facility ( $22.45 \%$ ) as well as students not having any interest in using pools ( $35.71 \%$ ). Only $46.58 \%$ of students would use the facility under it's current conditions. Improved pool facilities (30.43\%) and an indoor facility (27.33\%) were seen as the top priorities for the Townsville Campus. There was also a strong importance amongst students for more drinking stations for water as well as more spectator seating and shade.

## Cairns

All sporting facilities across the campus get used evenly with the JCU Oval being the most used sporting facility ( $52.38 \%$ ) however the JCU Gym is deemed as the most important sporting facility in Cairns. This statement is reinforced as $96.83 \%$ of respondents will or may likely be using the facility when opened including $100 \%$ of respondents who selected that they have used the JCU Gym before. While evenly spread across all days of the week, Friday's is deemed to be the most popular day for students to use the new gym ( $74.60 \%$ ) closely followed by Monday (69.84\%) and Wednesday ( $68.25 \%$ ). Students are also most likely be using the facility from 7:30pm-9:30pm (41.27\%), 5:30am-7:30am (38.10\%) and 5:30pm7:30pm (36.51\%).
An indoor facility (36.51\%) and improved gym facilities (33.33\%) were the top priorities amongst students however there was also a strong importance for a pool to be located on campus (mean average rating of 3.83).

## Social Sport

## Cairns

Physical activity ( $92.86 \%$ ) and continual engagement with friends ( $75.00 \%$ ) were seen as the most popular reasons why students participate in Cairns Social Sport. Last than half of respondents (42.86\%) indicated they played social sport this semester with $56.25 \%$ indicating that it was due to clashes to their university schedule. When asking what sport they would prefer to be added, basketball ( $28.57 \%$ ) was the most strongly agreeing with this statement.

## Fisher Shield

Fisher Shield is seen as an important program to both JCUSA Sport and to students. $98.36 \%$ of students agreed or strongly agreed that Fisher Shield enhances the experience of living on program has allowed them to meet new people/friends. sults were evenly spread all sports. When asked if we were to include/replace a sport, the addition of AFL was seen as the most popular option (32.79\%).

## Interfaculty Sport

Students believe Interfaculty Sport is an important program with $86.11 \%$ agree or strongly agree that Interfaculty Sport enhances their university experience as well as being an important program to JCUSA Sport. In addition, the survey showed that Interfaculty Sport allowed them to meet new people/friends with $88.89 \%$ ( $32 / 36$ respondents) agreeing or Rugby league is seen as the most important sport in the program (36.11\%) followed by touch football and basketball (both $25.00 \%$ ). Only $57.78 \%$ of respondents felt the cancellation the touch football and soccer competitions affected their overall experience.

One area that has been identified is the lack of students who were involved in the program ( $22.36 \%$ ) in comparison to Social Sport ( $49.07 \%$ ) and Fisher Shield ( $37.8 \%$ ) considering this a free program for all students in Townsville.
If another sport was added/replaced, AFL was deemed most popular (36.11\%).

## Gunyarra Cup

While a very young program first established in 2018, the program is starting to become an important part of the students university calendar. $72.22 \%$ ( $13 / 18$ respondents) agree or strongly agree that the Gunyarra Cup enhances the experience of living on campus. In addition to this statement, $83.33 \%$ agree or strongly agree Gunyarra Cup has allowed them to meet new people/friends while $77.78 \%$ agree or strongly agree that the program is important to JCUSA Sport. 64.29\% of respondents who were living on campus 2020 felt the cancellation of Gunyarra Cup impacted their overall experience.
Both basketball and soccer were seen as the most important sports to students within the program (both at 44.44\%).
When asked which sport we they prefer to have added, it was evenly spread across a variety of sports however cricket and tennis were the most popular choices. Students also prefer the event to be held throughout the year with $72.22 \%$ indicating that (50.00\% - Held throughout the semester, $22.22 \%$ happy with either option).

## Clubs

$89.29 \%$ said they were not apart of an affiliated JCU Sporting Club. This number increases to $91.00 \%$ as 6 respondents indicated they were members of clubs that were not an affiliated JCU Sporting Club. From those who are not apart of an affiliated club, $80.00 \%$ of respondents indicated that they are not involved with a sporting club outside of JCU $(77.67 \%$ when reclassifying 6 responses). Basketball and soccer (both $17.39 \%$ ) were seen as the most common sports that students will play outside of JCU. From the students who are members of clubs outside of JCU, $70.00 \%$ of respondents indicated that they were apart of that club because a club for their sport does not exist at JCU/on campus.

Students have identified the need to have a JCU sporting club and a facility located on cam-
pus. $72.50 \%$ of respondents say they are more likely to join a JCU sporting club on campus tailored to their sport meanwhile $78.00 \%$ of respondents are more likely to join the JCU sporting club if there was a facility based on campus.

While the number of students who were apart of clubs is small, those students have indicated the importance of sporting clubs particularly those that are located on campus. $100 \%$ of respondents agree or strongly agree that being part of a JCU Sporting Club has allowed them to meet new people/friends, created university spirit and culture and enhanced their university experience.

## UniSport Nationals

$97.32 \%$ of respondents indicated they have not competed at UniSport Nationals. Of those respondents, $48.62 \%$ said they were not aware that UniSport Nationals existed. In addition to this $29.82 \%$ of respondents said they have no interest in competing at a serious competition. Not knowing anyone on the team (21.56\%) and having university assessment or placement at the same time of the event ( $20.18 \%$ ) were also other reasons for not competing .

Respondents identified the importance of team spirit and team chemistry as a main focus of UniSport Nationals as that statement had the highest mean average rating (4.05). Football/ Soccer ( $11.16 \%$ ) and basketball ( $9.82 \%$ ) were seen as the most popular sports to competing at Nationals in 2021.

When it came to paying to compete at nationals $\$ 200-\$ 300$ ( $29.02 \%$ ) was the most popular amount for a week event (taking into consideration of registration, flights, uniforms and accommodation). This was followed by \$301-\$400 (20.54\%) and \$401-\$500 (16.52\%).

## Other Events

Students also indicated the interest of representing JCU in sport outside of UniSport Nationals. $71.43 \%$ said they would participate/compete in an event on campus where they can represent JCU in their chosen sport. $72.77 \%$ also said that they would they would also participate against other universities if they came to Townsville or Cairns to compete against JCU.

JCU students were also interested in playing for JCU if they went and compete in different towns across North Queensland with $82.14 \%$ indicating their interest. $50.45 \%$ did indicate it would depend on the costs while $41.96 \%$ also said it would also depend on what sports were played.
Students are also interested in an intercampus competition between Townsville and Cairns with $86.61 \%$ interested in participating. $41.52 \%$ of respondents said it would be dependent on the sports are played while $36.61 \%$ said it would depend on the costs.

Other Information
Monday's ( $50.45 \%$ ) is the preferred day to play sport at JCU. This was closely followed with Wednesday's (48.21\%). In Townsville, Monday is the most popular day to play sport on campus at $56.52 \%$ meanwhile Wednesday's and Friday's (both at $53.97 \%$ ) were the preferred days to play sport at the Cairns campus.

Students prefer to play sport on campus at night with $51.34 \%$ of respondents indicating this. A further $20.09 \%$ are happy to play sport either during in the day or night while $18.30 \%$ would play sport both in the day and at night.

Students have also indicated the possibility of playing social sport during the day as $71.49 \%$ have some interest in participating however it is dependent on their university schedule ( $50.89 \%$ ) and what day it is held as well as cost (29.01\%)
