Position Overview.

The role of the Interfaculty Sports Representative is to provide assistance with planning, organising and communication of the Interfaculty Sport competition to students within their respective faculty.

The Interfaculty Sports Representative is required to assist with the operation of organising teams within their faculty for the Interfaculty Sport Competition, being the main point of contact between students and JCU Sport and as well as helping promote Interfaculty Sport to new and current students within their respective faculty.

Student Association.

The James Cook University Student Association is an organisation directed by elected students which aims to provide high quality representation, support services and relevant non-academic activities to all of its members.

Duties.

- 1. Assist with operation matters of Interfaculty Sport including but not limited to.
 - Organising teams for different competitions as well as trainings/trials.
 - Collecting the team uniforms from JCU Sport and returning them back upon the completion of each competition.
 - Submitting squad lists to JCU Sport prior to the competition.
 - Helping out on the night of competition including ensuring that the team is ready to play.
 - Helping promote Interfaculty Sport to new and current students within their respective faculty.
 - Working closely with JCU Sport to help improve the structure and organisation of Interfaculty Sport and other sporting programs (wherever necessary).

- 2. Promote and support the SA's commitment to the recognition of original custodians, which exemplify respect for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander heritage and the valuing of justice and equity for all Australians.
- 3. Demonstrate a commitment to the James Cook University Student Association's values.

Selection Criteria

Selection and appointments will be assessed against selection criteria:

- 1. Sound organisational and time management skills including the ability to plan, implement and help deliver sports programs.
- 2. Effective interpersonal skills and written and verbal communication skills that can be adapted for various audiences.
- 3. Skills and knowledge of common sports as well as the ability to be motivated for each competition no matter the sport.
