

Re: Undergraduate vs Postgraduate students

Dear candidates,

During the pre-election briefing a question came up in relation to who constitutes as a postgraduate vs undergraduate student.

I have made contact with the enrolments department at JCU to clarify this.

Any student enrolled in a Bachelor course is an undergraduate student; this includes Honours students as they are Bachelor students.

Postgraduate students are students enrolled in a Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma, Masters or HDR studies.

The information around what constitutes as undergraduate and postgraduate studies can also be found in the course handbook.
