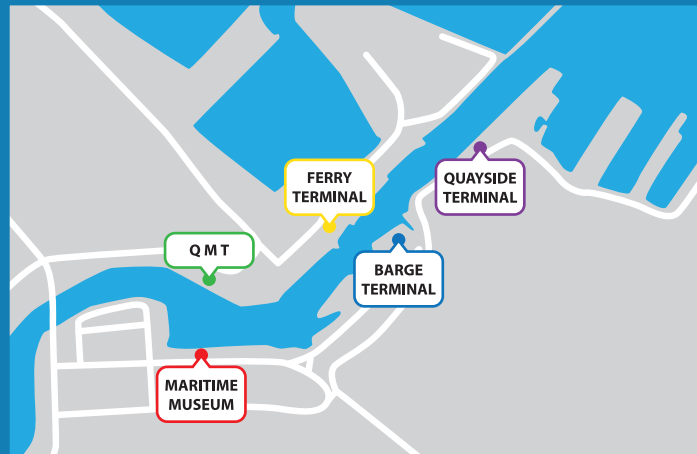
The purpose of this guide is to assist you in “navigating” your way around the museum, enabling you to discover the numerous items we display and to experience the stories they tell.

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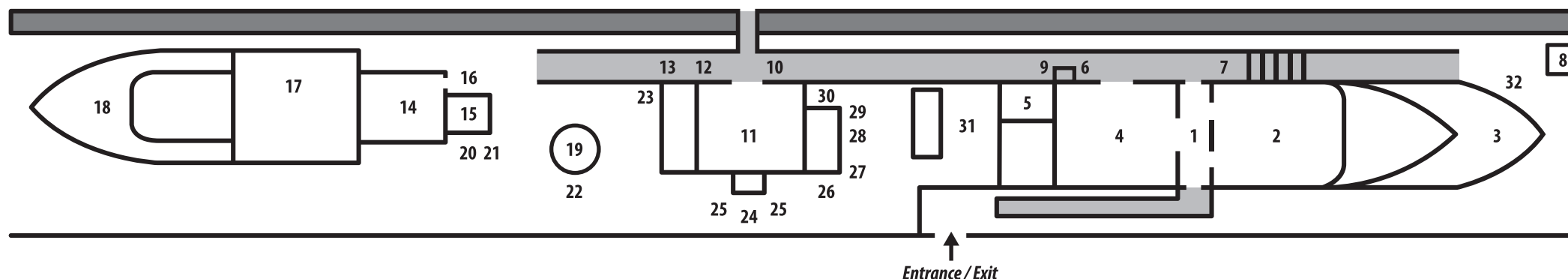
