Advocacy, Referrals & Information

MCCGC has been the Peak Body for Gold Coast multicultural communities since 1983. We are a central source of information and provide referrals and advocacy for community members.

Settlement **FREE**

We support and empower people who have recently arrived in Australia to access culturally appropriate services and navigate education, employment, health systems and reach their goals.



Employment & Training **FREE**

Our Hub provides one-on-one support to help Australians and all migrants reach their career goals. We help with upskilling, resumes & cover letters, interviews, English skills, workshops, mentorship and more!

Community Development **FREE**

Our program supports local community and cultural groups, offers free English classes, hosts quarterly community leader dinners, provides cultural training and runs a Youth Advisory Group.



Mental Health & Wellbeing Support **FREE**

We offer two inclusive, community-based mental health programs, Culture in Mind and Community Pathway Connector, that provide culturally sensitive, non-clinical support to individuals at any stage of their wellness journey, with no visa requirements.

Disability **For NDIS participants with Support Coordination**

We help community members with disabilities, including physical, intellectual and psychological and their families to understand what services and funds are available in their NDIS plans and connect with community and providers.

We know navigating aged care can feel overwhelming for many individuals and families and we are here to help you on the journey so you can find the support that best meets your unique needs.

Cura Aged Care is a branch of MCCGC that provides in-home and community care to seniors. We also have a wellness centre for social and physical activities. Our staff speak over 40 languages.
