EDUCATION PROGRAM

Kindergarten program operates during school terms. Please see kindergarten calendar for operating dates for each group.

Group A – attends Monday, Tuesday and alternating Wednesday (8.15am to 2.45pm)

Group B – attends Thursday, Friday and alternating Wednesday (8.15am to 2.45pm)

***Full Time** – attends Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday (8.15am to 2.45pm)

* Full Time positions utilise two eligible Kindergarten positions. Due to Kindergarten funding guidelines, we are unable to offer any full time positions until the beginning of February once the Kindergarten year has commenced to allow access to all eligible enrolments.

KINDERGARTEN FEES (information current as at January 2026, fees and subsidies are subject to change)

Daily rate for Kindy Eligible children (children who turn 4 <u>before</u> the 30 th June in the year they attend)	FREE KINDY (Group A or Group B)
Daily rate for Kindy Non-Eligible children (children who turn 4 <u>after</u> the 30 th June in the year they attend or children enrolled in another Kindy program)	\$109 per day (Group A or Group B)
Full Time Rate (Full time positions utilise both Group A and Group B and funding is only eligible for one position.)	FREE for Group A and \$109 per day for Group B
Inclusions in the total daily rate	QLD Kindergarten Program, incursions, excursions, sunscreen, and insect repellent

ADDITIONAL FEES

Non-refundable Enrolment Deposit: (consists of \$40 enrolment fee and a \$100 credit applied to account upon commencement)	\$140.00
Direct Debit Rejection fee: (per occurrence)	\$3.00
Late collection fee: For every 15 minutes or part thereof per child per occurrence	\$20.00

Fees are reviewed annually and may be increased each year. Quality care for children, affordability for families and financial viability of the service are the key elements in determining fees.

In addition:

- All fees must be paid to the end of the previous week of care
- Failure to pay childcare fees at least fortnightly may result in suspension of enrolment until fees are paid in full.
- Failure to pay fees incurred within the prescribed timeframe may result in withdrawal of care places until fees are paid in full or payment plan arrangement made.
- Failure to adhere to agreement may result in account referral to a debt collection agency, cost of which will be added to accounts
- All payments received will be receipted as per fee payment policy
- If experiencing financial hardship payment plans are available, please speak with the Service Leader for further information.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

This is a not for profit, self-funded service. We rely on the prompt payment of fees to maintain effective and efficient operations. Our only regular operating income comes directly from Child Care Benefit and Parent Fees. Please ensure your account remains up to date.

APPROVED KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM PROVIDER

This service holds a current service approval for a centre based service in Queensland, under the Education and Care Services National Law (National Law) or the Education and Care Services Act 2013, and appropriate public liability insurance of at least \$10 million. To be eligible to receive kindergarten funding the service must meet specific requirements, including provide an approved kindergarten program:

- To children who are at least four years of age by 30 June in the year they commence kindergarten
- Delivered by a qualified early childhood teacher
- Aligned with the Queensland Kindergarten Learning Guideline, or other education program approved by the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority
- For 600 hours annually made up of 15 hours a week or 30 hours per fortnight for 40 weeks. Any other model must be approved by the Department of Education prior to commencement
